- A. Dictionary - The perceptive and thinking part of consciousness, exclusive of will and emotion.
- B. Urentia Book -
1. The thinking, perceiving, and feeling mechanism of the human organism, The total conscious and unconscious experience, The intelligence associated with the emotional life reaching upward through worship and wisdom to the wspirit level. (1)
 2. Mind is the vital link - the indispensable channel of communication between spiritual and material realities. (2-5)

III. Types of Mind

- A. Spirit Mind (6-8)
1. Spirit is ever conscious, intelligent, minded - it is ancestor to the mind of the Conjoint Actor.
 2. The mind of the Father and the Son is best illustrated by the pre-mind of the Thought Adjuster.
- B. Absolute Mind - Absolute Mind-Gravity Circuit
1. Mind of the Third Person (9-13)
 - a. Infinite, utterly transcends the active and functioning mind circuits of the universe of universes.
 - b. Ignores time; is independent of space.
 2. The Third Source and Center is the source of mind.
 - a. All activities of mind are grasped in the absolute mind-gravity circuit which focalizes in the Third Source and Center. (14-24)
 - b. The Infinite Spirit draws all intellectual values Paradiseward. (25)
 - c. Havona is the mind laboratory of the Spirit. (26,27)
- C. The Cosmic Mind
1. The Master Spirits are the seven fold source of the cosmic mind, the intellectual potential of the Grand Universe. Cosmic mind is cognizant of the presence of all thinking creatures. (28-30,37)
 2. Cosmic mind is a sub-absolute manifestation of the mind of the Third Source and Center. (29)
 3. Mortals do not experience the direct influence of Seven Master Spirits, but are under immediate influence of Creative Spirit of Nebadon. (29,31-36)

1. Nebadon order of Orvonton series of Cosmic mind. (35,36,38,39)
 2. The Adjutant Spirit mind - seven adjutant mind spirits (40-50)
 - a. The spirit of intuition - quick perception - reflex instincts.
 - b. The spirit of understanding - automatic association of ideas.
 - c. The spirit of courage - fidelity endowment.
 - d. The spirit of knowledge - curiosity - mother of adventure, discovery.
 - e. The spirit of counsel - social urge - gregarious instinct.
 - f. The spirit of worship - religious impulse - badge of spiritual asc.
 - g. The spirit of wisdom - goal of purely mental and moral existence.
