

STANDARDS OF ADMISSION OF URANTIA SOCIETIES

FOR THE QUALIFICATION OF INDIVIDUALS MAKING APPLICATION
TO BE CHARTERED AS A URANTIA SOCIETY
OF URANTIA BROTHERHOOD

1. Applicants shall have read, ^{all} the URANTIA Book, shall have a reasonable knowledge of its contents, and shall profess a sincere belief in its teachings.
2. Applicants shall have read the Constitution and By-laws of URANTIA Brotherhood and shall declare their willingness to accept them.
3. Applicants shall all be citizens or residents in good standing in the community and in the country in which the Urantia Society is to be established.
4. Applicants shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
5. Applicants shall agree, when admitting members to the proposed Urantia Society, to abide by the Standards of Admission for the qualification of persons making application for membership in Urantia Societies, which standards have been made available by the Charter Committee.
6. There must be ten (10) or more applicants.
7. Applicants shall agree that by the time of their installation, or before, they will have decided upon the provisions of their proposed society constitution, so that, not later than thirty (30) days thereafter, they can adopt the constitution, elect officers, and function as an organized society.

NOTE: Applicants' membership in any church, religious organization, or fraternal society shall not disqualify them as founders of a Urantia Society.
