Good moral character.

Expressed belief in the teachings of the Urantia Book.
Loyalty to the purposes of the Urantia Brotherhood.
Membership in the Urantia Brotherhood.
Willingness to assume responsibilities and ability to complete projects.
Ability to accept criticism gracefully.
Possession of open-mindedness, tact, and tolerance.
Interest in people and readiness to serve others.
Ability to think independently and to act without prejudice.
Average emotional stability.

At least one complete reading of the Urantia Book.

KNOWLEDGE OF PAPERS

At least one complete reading of the Urantia Book.

Presentation of a thesis based on the Urantia Book.

ABILITIES

Ability to lead groups or to take active part in public meetings.
Ability to organize and successfully carry out projects.
Some gift in self-expression and ability to talk in public.
Some promise of teaching ability.

ABILITIES

It is assumed that Teacher candidates are possessed of abilities required of Leader candidates.
Speaking or teaching ability above the average.
Ability to lead and to inspire co-operation.

EXPERIENCE

Experience in or capacity for leadership.

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Leadership experience in churches, religious groups, civic, social, political, or business organizations.
or
Capacity for the above.
