

— Recommendations of Workshop Participants to the Committee on Education of the
Urantia Brotherhood, July 28, 1975

"The Book is being given to those who are ready for it long before its worldwide mission. In the meantime thousands of study groups must be brought into existence. Thus will the Book be in readiness to comfort and enlighten the peoples of the world when the battle for man's liberty is finally won and the world is once more made safe for the religion of Jesus and the freedom of mankind." 1. In light of this statement:

We move that the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee foster the creation and promulgation of URANTIA Book Study Groups throughout the world as the most significant foundation for the dissemination of the URANTIA revelation.

Vote: yes-35 no-0 abstention-3

2. As the great need for resource coordination has been expressed in the conference by you:

We move that the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee create a Resource Center which will serve all levels of URANTIA Book students in the following areas by:

- a) Collecting all available study aids and guides.
- b) Making available study aids and guides to all individuals, study groups, Field Representatives and Societies on a worldwide basis.
- c) Gathering from the individual, study groups and Societies a list of resource specialists.
- d) Publishing a catalog listing all these resources.
- e) Advising individuals seeking specialized training.

Vote: yes-28 no-5 abstention-3

3. Because of an expressed need for more effective communications among URANTIA Book students:

We move that the Executive Committee of the URANTIA Brotherhood expand and strengthen the existing communication channels of the URANTIA movement.

Vote: yes-33 no-1 abstention-5

4. Because of the importance of these issues:

We move that the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee reconvene the Summer Workshop of the URANTIA Brotherhood School in 1976.

Vote: yes-30 no-2 abstention-6

5. In order to gain wider involvement and perspective:

We move that the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee conduct a survey of the participants in the General Conference to determine their educational needs and goals.

Vote: yes-20 no-11 abstention-8

6. Because of the need for continuity in thinking and communication:

We move that the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee inform all Workshop Participants of actions resulting from these proposals.
