Long-term objectives of the Committee on Education (with regard to Workshop):

- To prepare teachers and leaders of <u>The URANTIA Book</u> and URANTIA movement with an ongoing, related educational experience and/or process.
- To demonstrate effective teaching techniques as well as effective use of educational materials.
- To draw upon and apply the education methodology which is expressed directly or subtly in The URANTIA Book.

General Objectives for the 1978 Workshop:

- To structure this particular workshop so that it may be expanded upon and related to later workshops in years to come.
- To acquaint those genuinely interested in teaching to a variety of educational techniques.
- To emphasize the "how" of teaching as opposed to the "what." Methods as opposed to content.
- 4. To provide an environment which encourages involvement and active participation.

Specific Objectives and Format:
