THE FOLLOWING LETTER WAS SENT TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE FIRST
URANTIA SOCIETY OF HOUSTON:

Individually addressed.

January 11, 1980

You were earlier notified of a hearing before the Judicial Committee of URANTIA Brotherhood affecting the charter of the First URANTIA Society of Houston arising from its failure to execute the Licensing Agreement with URANTIA Foundation.

I am pleased to advise you that the scheduled hearing has now been cancelled. The Judicial Committee has been advised by URANTIA Foundation that it has received and approved the Licensing Agreement executed by the Houston Society in December 1979.

The significance of this event is that you are not in jeopardy of losing your membership in URANTIA Brotherhood through the loss of the Houston charter at such hearing.

The Houston Society is to be congratulated upon its decision. I hope and pray that the action will be accepted by all members of the Society and that the members will unify themselves in a spirit of conciliation without the necessity of any form of action by the Brotherhood.

Let us all bind up old wounds and unite in the important work of spreading the fifth epochal revelation.
