The Index draft should enable you to see the scope and general philosophy of the Topical Index. IT IS NOT A FINISHED PRODUCT.

The three columns in the draft are: 1) Primary topic
2) Secondary (sub-)topic, and
3) Citation

(The format of the draft was designed to enable sorting; the multiple repetitions of primary topics in the first field will be removed.)

As you can see in the short sample of the finished format, the primary topic is listed only once and is flush left, while sub-topics are indented slightly and are listed below the primary topic. Citations follow each sub-topic (or primary, if there is no secondary field) and if there is more than one citation for a given topic, the citations are simply listed after that topic.

As a general principle, I have attempted to cite those locations in the text which discuss a particular topic in some detail or in a particularly vivid manner. An effort has been made to locate a citation under multiple topics so that the different logical approaches by differing readers will successfully locate the information sought. For example, if you wanted to locate Jesus' saying, "Where your treasure is, there will your heart be also," you could find it in the following places:

This is a larger number of cross-references than most topics have, but it illustrates the concept well.

There are currently about 7,200 references, a number which should increase to 7,500 or so during the rationalization process. The work which remains to be done involves a careful review of the entries to ensure reasonable consistency and balance of attention to the various topics, as well as mechanics of presentation such as cross-references. In my estimate, this remaining editorial work can be completed in 2-3 weeks with an additional week required to convert the file into a format which will be easy for Nancy Johnson to typeset (removing duplicate primary references, mainly)

When complete, and after converting the Index into the final 2-column format, it will probably be about 100 pages in length. (This is somewhat shorter than my earlier estimates because my testing of the conversion to 2-columns has saved more space than I thought.)

I look forward to your comments and suggestions.
