Greetings! The following two quotes from page 215 of the original publication of *The Urantia Book* provide background for discussing the purpose of the Fellowship's Oral History Project:

19:1.6 ... The true perspective of any reality problem--human or divine, terrestrial or cosmic--can be had only by the full and unprejudiced study and correlation of three phases of universe reality: origin, history, and destiny. The proper understanding of these three experiential realities affords the basis for a wise estimate of the current status.

19:1.11... The present can be truly interpreted only in the light of the correlated past and future.

More than 40 years have passed since *The Urantia Book* became publically available. Many things have changed since those early days when everything about this amazing revelation had to be kept in strictest confidence.

Since 1988 the Special Project Committee has had the assignment of gathering information wherever possible from those who participated in the Forum and/or the Seventy — with no intention of attempting to wrest secrets or to breach trust — through a personal interview process. Our charge is not to uncover secrets but rather to get a sense of the personal experiences from those earlier times. You are not being asked to betray a trust but to help to build on a very important dimension of the Urantia Movement — shared personal experience. We hope that you will be willing to share the benefits of your experience.

During the next several weeks, Barbara Kulieke, a member of the Special Projects Committee, will be calling you to discuss this project. She will very much want to speak with you in person and to set up a convenient time for an interview during which, with your permission, she can make a recording of your conversation. These are the types of topics she will hope to discuss with you during the interview:

- 1. Your background
- 2. Your introduction to the revelation
- 3. The kinds of meetings in which you participated
- 4. The people with whom you interacted

- 5. Your relationship with the book
- 6. What the 1940s and '50s were like for you and the revelation
- 7. What you foresee as the future for the revelation
