In response to your question concerning the book store in Eagle Rock we have the following information: First, we called information for the telephone number and then when they gave that to us, asked if it is listed as a Book Store and they said "Yes,". Also I asked if it is a new listing and they said, "No". This may be of some help to you as you can do this any place in the United States through "Information" at no expense.

Of course I realized that you wanted more specific information so Bill and I drove out there this morning. It is about an hour's drive from here and about five or six blocks from the Research Foundation (Urantia). The store opened at noon and was mostly second hand books and we didn't see the Urantia Book on any shelves. However they are near Occidental College and a very good place to sell the Urantia Books. I, of course wonder if Burton King didn't just ask him to order the books for him and he agreed to do so. It is a bona fide book store which moved from El Cerritos about March of this year. I'll enclose the card. It is also the kind of book store which sells occult and religious books of all kinds. It is in a nice location with the mountains looming up behind and just off of Colorado Blvd.

Bill and I drove past Burton King's hoping they had taken down their sign *but* it is still there.

David Reed just called me and he seems to attend various kinds of meetings and said he had gone to one last night where four ladies were from the Burton King group and they had decided to not go to his meetings any more because "his ego had turned them off" ha! David is better than a Pepys Diary, he is always giving me bits of pertinent information from here and there. He also went down to visit the people who publish Chimes near Encinitas and said a very nice lady met with him and said they often publish things from the Urantia Book. This place is near San Diego and if you remember is the publication that did the piece on Rebecca a couple or so years ago. *mailed it to 533 then*

Vern surprised us with a telephone call the day I was getting dinner for the eight newcomers. Luckily I had the table set, the bread and rolls baked, the salads made, so I dropped everything and took him from the airport way up miles to Hollywood where one other group was competing with him for a Sunday night spot on XPRS, Soul Station, a powerful station which can be heard in 15 states with a few million listenership. I sat in the car and prayed that the kingdom of God would be enlarged and when Vern came out he had this contract and they had his tapes ready to mail to the Mexican station which broadcasts. Tomorrow night we will hear him at 7 p.m. A station geared to young people. Then it started to pour and we crept through heavy going-home traffic and I had a beautiful dinner on for 12 by 7 p.m. Vern gave us some beautiful messages and it was a great evening. Then he stayed all night and we had some more good visits in the morning. Life is very full and almost all Urantia now. *1640: #1*

Hope this answers your question and I'll get it in mail tonight. Marty's company is written up in the December Wall Street Reports, just out. Marty's company is under E.D.C of Tulas Oklahoma and Marty is president of Career Development Corporation about four pages on this and all very good documentary.
