The Society is a separate organization and is part of our organization. Bill Grisso is President, and Salyer has some kind of honorary title I believe. Salyer is much more interested in his church than in our society. He wants to go out and start branches of the church so he needs a pastor to take over for him. It's very small. Bill Grisso wrote me what was in the wind, but I haven't heard whether he's found a man or not.
