Because we have reached a time in our evolution when a number of decisions must be taken which will have lasting effect upon our future growth, it is important that we approach these decisions with a sure sense of our long term strategic goals.

I ask each one of you to share in the formulation of these goals. Our purpose is threefold:

- o To provide sound reference points for evaluation and review of short term objectives;
- o To enhance all decisions relating to the commitment of resources and evaluation of strategic opportunities; and
- o To provide a focus within the framework of the mission defined in Article 2 for the coordination and unification of the work of URANTIA Brotherhood throughout the world.

The word "strategic" is used to suggest goals of sufficient magnitude to exert profound influence upon the URANTIA movement for decades or even centuries to come.
