Dear Miss Rawley:

I plan to be in Chicago September 7th and leave Sept. 10th. Both evenings of Sept. 8th and 9th are occupied but the evening of Sept. 7th or Saturday afternoon and evening are free and I would like to visit the Urantia Foundation. If you should so desire, I can present a lecture on my Graphical Cosmology which I presented to four of your members in September 1961. As you may recall it incorporates all of the Urantia Universe structure within the now known radio and optical telescope astrophysical data. Such a lecture might take 2 1/2 to 3 hours and would only make good sense to those members who have thoroughly read the scientific side of Urantia.

During the last two years I have been doing some special research work with a sensitive who is attuned to the Celestial Group with Urantia. The result is a group of drawings in color which show the Celestial energy control systems and techniques used by the Transmitters and Receivers to enseraphimethe Angelic Entities for travel from an Architectual Sphere to a planet and return. Details include the whirling energy fields required to accelerate an Entity at 3 times the speed of light, the shape they take in transit and the recovery envelope form assumed on arrival and departure. The transmission corridors are special truncated cones surrounded by complex electrical field grids, apparently manipulated much the same as we do electrons in a TV kinoscope tube. I would be happy to present these if you think it is an area that would be of interest.

I would also like to talk to Dr. Sadler again if it is possible and Dr. Earl Douglas, of Princeton, N.J., whom I visited this past week, also sends Dr. Sadler his best.

Please arrange to have two copies of the Urantia Book on hand for me as I would like to bring them back with me. May I hear from you by return mail.

Dear Alvin:

Here is a letter Christy and I thought you should see.. I will not reply until we hear from you.

We both agree that we should decline the offer of a lecture, and I will say that Dr. Sadler sees very few people and that ^{an} interview will not be possible.

You are the only person who can talk to him with any degree of understanding. Would you want to come in to talk with him Wednesday night, Sept. 7, or Saturday afternoon, Sept. 10? If you would prefer not to, or cannot because of previous engagements, I will see him and simply explain that I know nothing about physics and just talk generally.

I am sure you remember who he is and have seen his charts - which are wrong. The four members he mentions that he talked to in 1961 were Edith Cook, Al Leverenz, Bob McGowan, and me - in my apartment. When we pointed out errors in his charts and in his reasoning, he would not accept our corrections. In addition to being wrong in his scientific facts, he is very involved in occult things apparently - for example, the "sensitive" with whom he is working. He also told us that there were 3-brained people on this planet who came from other planets and Edith and I couldn't convince him to the contrary. You may also remember that he had pictures of flying saucers taking off from the moon, and some other flying saucer pictures. In short, he's a difficult man to deal with, and has very strong opinions, some of them contrary to our teachings.

I would welcome your help, but I really hate to have you waste an evening or afternoon. If I see him alone, I can perhaps brush him off rather briefly by pleading ignorance of what he's talking about. I'm quite sure that nothing we say will change his mind about anything so there will be no chance to get in any missionary work.

Please call either Christy or me as soon as you get this letter, giving us your opinion on what we should do, so I can answer the letter as soon as possible, as time is getting short. If you call during the day, please call Christy as I cannot take calls like this on my job. In the evening either Christy or I can take the call - my phone is 327-5029.

Arnold A. Zachow phoned Saturday morning. He couldn't come in Saturday afternoon as I had suggested so talked over half an hour on the phone.

Wanted to know how many books we had left and what it would cost for the next printing. I told him - and that the Foundation was now soliciting for money. Wanted to know how and where the books were going - told him through many bookstores. Wanted to know if there was any group on the east coast. I said none that we knew of.

Asked if there was anything unusual going on here. Was the contact person being questioned again? Said he had heard rumors to that effect. I said I was very sure no more questioning was going on - in fact, I didn't even know whether the contact was alive. I said nothing unusual was going on here or anywhere ~~in~~ else, that I knew of. Told him of the groups in Los Angeles and Oklahoma City. He didn't know about the French edition so I gave him the news of that - and about Tahiti. Also told him there were many books in Australia, but most of the owners were interested in other things - and he has no use for the New Age, etc.

He is not doing anything with the maps he gave us. Said he hadn't done anything with them since that time. I asked if he gave lectures using the Urantia material and he said definitely not. He feels most minds aren't up to the material, so when he talks about the concepts it's individually to people he feels can understand. He thinks it's important to get young people interested. Has talked recently with young scientists and they are very receptive to the concepts. I pointed out that the spiritual part of the book is the most important and the science secondary. He said he realized that, but felt that in this scientific age we had to approach many through the science angle.

Asked to be put on the Bulletin list and said he will send a check for 2 books.

Asked about Bob McGowan - said he considered him a very ~~unusual~~ unusual talented person. Also asked about Dr. Sprunger. He said he had met him and had been very impressed. I gave him Meredith's address. Said Ted Key did not read much of the book - didn't fit with his beliefs. Joe Crossen has read the book several times and is devoted to it.

Asked about our meetings and who was leading them, and who was qualified to teach Part I, which was rather difficult. I named Alvin, Doctor, and Ruth Burton, & *Edith Cook*.

He talked a great deal about the "sensitive" he's working with and how she can see energy paths and draw them in color. When he first started getting this information from her she had not seen the book. Now she has it and is struggling through, but she ~~doesn't~~ doesn't have a very good mind. Also talked about the pictures of the big vehicles moving off the moon. I reminded him he had shown them to us. He said Dr. Earle Douglas is very involved about the "scout cars" - which are UFOs, but ~~he~~ himself is

very indifferent to those. He's concerned with the big stuff like the 10 mile long things in his moon picture.

He also said that Dr. Douglas knows very little about the Urantia Book. Said he asked him several questions about Adam and Eve and some other points he should know about - and Douglas was not familiar with them.

He seems to have mellowed somewhat and perhaps is a little more pliable. He was very cordial and friendly on the phone.

I told him I would check the list and send ~~him~~ him the names of anyone interested in his area. Also want to send him the last Bulletin and Ruth Burton's "Concepts."
