

MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
OF URANTIA BROTHERHOOD

October 5, 1959

The regular meeting of the Executive Committee was held at 8:00 P.M., October 5, 1959, at 533 Diversey Parkway, Chicago 14, Illinois.
