

MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
OF URANTIA BROTHERHOOD

July 5, 1960

The regular meeting of the Executive Committee was held at 8:00 P.M. July 5, 1960, at 533 Diversey Parkway, Chicago 14, Illinois.

Ruth F. Burton was absent. The meeting was called to order by Warren Kulieke with Marian Rowley acting as Secretary.

The minutes of the last meeting held on June 6, 1960, were read and approved. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the meeting recessed for an informal discussion.

Mrs. Sunderland, as Secretary of the Domestic Extension Committee, presented the revised statement prepared by the committee in answer to the question of the local societies as to what the Brotherhood expects of a local society. The revised statement was approved by the Executive Committee without further comment and the Secretary-General was instructed to send it to the societies and Field Representatives.

Dr. Sadler reported that a letter had been received from a representative of Lowell Thomas with an excerpt from a forthcoming book about Sir Hubert Wilkins, which mentioned the Urantia Book and our organization. Dr. Sadler replied that the excerpt was acceptable to us, but suggested that it be removed from the chapter in which it had been placed as the Urantia Book had no connection with mental telepathy or extra-sensory perception, with which the chapter was concerned. He suggested that it be included in another place.

The Chairman brought up the point that there seemed to have been some misunderstanding regarding the requirements for becoming an Ordained Teacher, and Dr. Sadler stated that the Committee on Education had set the standard as ten majors.

Items for the July Quarterly News Letter were suggested and discussed.

Mr. Mills announced that he had arranged a trip to the West Coast in August and had written the West Coast Urantia Society in an effort to set up a date to meet with them sometime during the weekend of August 12.
