

Fusla Minutes -- Gov. Board Meeting

January 8, 1967

The first quarterly ^{meeting} of the new year was called to order^d by President Ward Culbertson at his home at 7:15 P.M.

Julia Fenderson moved that we plan an assembly for Feb. 9 at Greys, notices of date and time to be sent out by Culbertsons. It was seconded by Dick Ziglar and carried. The next order of business concerned a discussion of the membership list. It was suggested by Ken Parke that a letter be sent to all members regarding dues which should preferably be paid on the first of the calendar year and the first of the fiscal year, twice annually.

Julia Fenderson moved that the Secretary be instructed to send a letter to members in the form of a census which will contain the following alternatives-- the opportunity to affirm membership as an active member of the FUSLA and - a place for official resignation. A stamped envelope should be enclosed with this letter. This was not voted on.

A motion was made by Polly Parke that in the future all meetings and assemblies be opened with some type of spoken or silent prayer. This was seconded by Julia Fenderson and passed. The meeting was adjourned by Ward Culbertson.
