Present: Julia Fenderson, President; Helen Steen, Treasurer; Ben Schiavo, Membership Chairman; Georgia Gecht, Secretary.

Meeting was called to order at 1:30 P.M. by the President.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. MOTION was made that the expense of printing of the school material be paid by the First Urantia Society of Los Angeles. APPROVED.
2. MOTION was made that the expense of printing the updated amendments to the Constitution which the Constitution Committee has previously submitted, be paid by F.U.S.L.A. APPROVED.

NEW BUSINESS:

3. MOTION was made and seconded, after much discussion about names for the new school, that the name- "SCHOOL OF MEANINGS AND VALUES" be adopted as the official name. This name met with the approval of everyone.  
Motion was seconded and APPROVED.
4. MOTION was made and seconded that the required coarse for students of the school to receive a diploma be set at eighteen hours. APPROVED.
5. MOTION was made that we continue the monthly study classes on the FIRST SUNDAY OF THE MONTH at 2:00 P.M. in Culver City. Place of meeting TO BE ANNOUNCED.  
APPROVED.

MEMBERSHIP BUSINESS:

6. The application of Mrs. Nancy Otte of Los Angeles to the First Urantia Society of Los Angeles for membership was read to the Board. The applicant was sponsored by Mrs. Helen Steen. The application was duly considered and approved unanimously for immediate initiation.
7. The application for reinstatement of Mrs. Pelly Parke as an active member of the First Urantia Society of Los Angeles was read to the Board by the Secretary. The application was fully approved.

Motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 1:55 P.M.

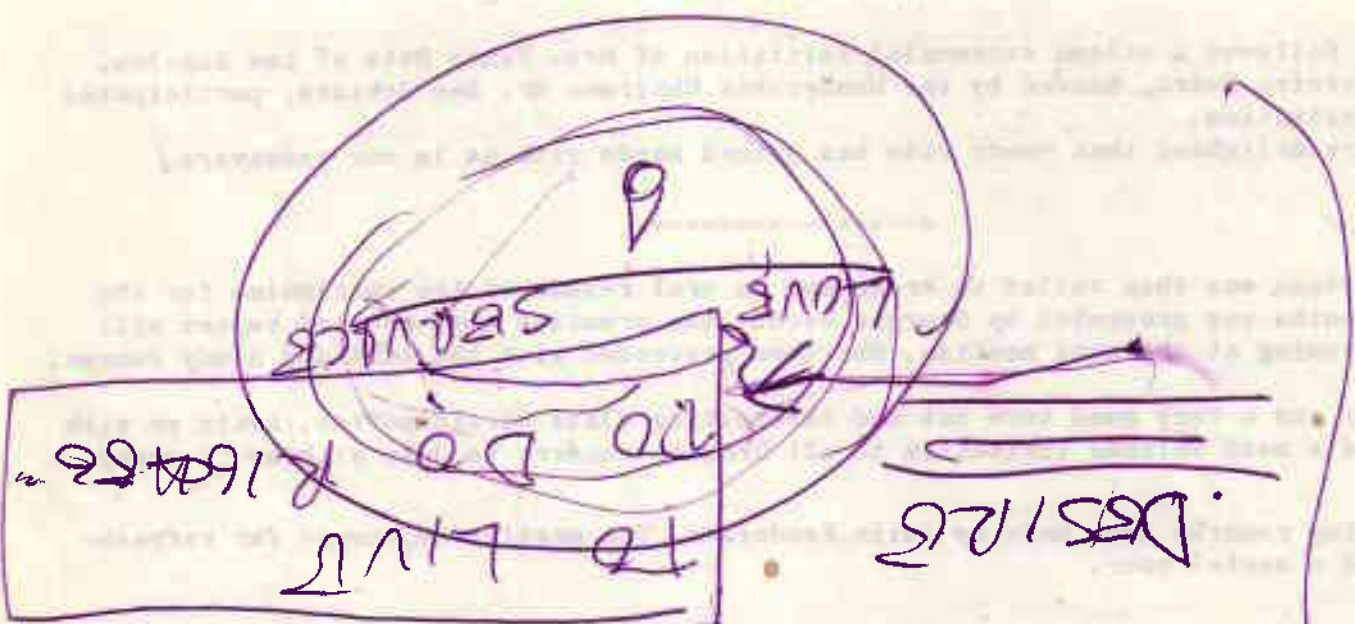
