WEDNESDAY, MARCH 21:

"EMERGING THEORIES OF REALITY" by Bob Hunt: Exploring the leading edge of science; its insights into the relationship between physical and spiritual reality in light of related information in The URANTIA Book.

THURSDAY, MARCH 22:

"UNIVERSAL WHOLENESS" by Bob Hunt: A consideration of the interrelatedness of all things and beings and the growing recognition of such a holistic principal. Here too, the advanced thought of our time is becoming aligned with that which is presented in The URANTIA Book.

BOB HUNT is a professor of mathematics at Humbolt State University in Arcata, California. Bob is a longtime reader of The URANTIA Book and has taught a college level credited class on the book. Parenting and family life are some of Bob's chief interests as the father of ten children and three step-children.

THURSDAY & FRIDAY, APRIL 26 & 27:

"RELIGION, SCIENCE, AND PLANETARY CULTURE" by Larry Goldberg: This seminar will review some of our urgent environmental problems, and consider the types of scientific progress and the changes in our world view which could help to solve these problems. The contributions which religious groups might make to our scientific and world view needs will be explored.

LARRY GOLDBERG has worked with a number of scientific institutions as an applied philosopher, has taught courses in environmental ethics, holistic research and the mind/body problem; he is presently completing his doctorate in philosophy at the University of Colorado in Boulder. Larry has also studied a number of religious philosophies, including Buddhist, Hindu, Gurdjieff, Cabbalistic, Theosophic and URANTIA Book teachings.

THURSDAY & FRIDAY, MAY 24 & 25:

"PERSPECTIVES ON HARMONY: HUMAN PERCEPTIONS & UNIVERSE MEANINGS" by Carol Chambers: Why is music the "universal language of men, angels and spirits"? Our eternal quest might be defined as seeking God's absolute harmony — the unification of the realities of truth, meanings of beauty and values of goodness.

CAROL CHAMBERS is a practicing musician and music teacher in Houston, Texas. She has toured Europe with the Glenn Miller Orchestra, performed for two years in a Broadway musical, and written songs for Dolly Parton. Carol is also a longtime reader of The URANTIA Book.
