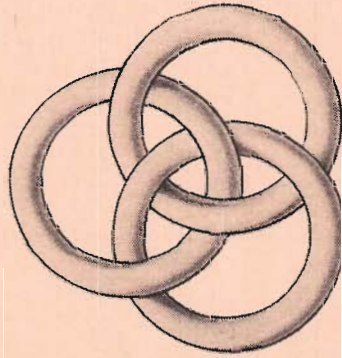
"Brain, Mind, and Spirit" Lawrence L. Schkade March 12, Saturday morning, from 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

This presentation, which Berkeley Elliott recommended to us, is a favorite among the Oklahoma group. Dr. Schkade is a professor at the University of Texas and Director of the Center for Research on Information Systems. We will learn about brain hemisphericity and how different types of people tend to solve problems in different ways. This seminar should help us function as a community with greater self-understanding and mutual appreciation. In order to derive full benefit from this seminar, it is necessary to come to the February 11 seminar to get the form which you can fill out and return to the school at the February 12 seminar. (The school will forward the completed forms to Dr. Schkade for scoring--so that he can come with data in hand about our group.)

One more note. The Boulder School has entered a period of severe belt-tightening. The seminar presenters this term are receiving no transportation expenses and no honoraria. 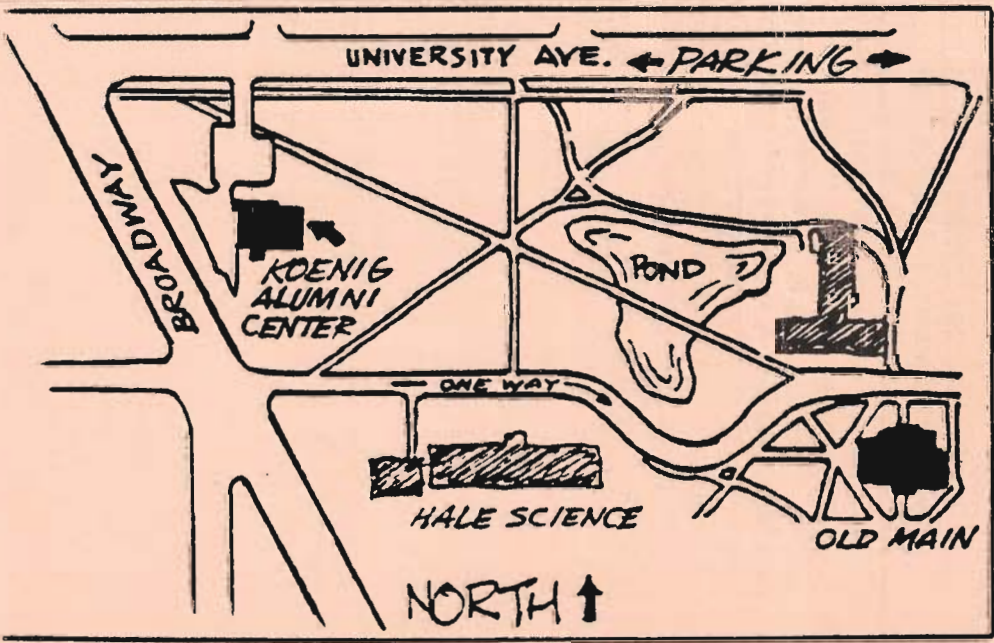
