- 11/16/96 — Governing Committee Meeting — Larry Geise's home
  - New members added: Nora & Saed Abdemaokher, Audrey Ayers, Claudia Ayers, Laurence Brown, Steve Graaskamp, Sara Harvey, Jerry Pando, Larry Watkins
  - Developments Newsletter: Pat Fearey and Jay Newbern volunteered to be proof readers.
  - Discussion of the possible updating of the Society Constitution.
  - Jerry Pando and Larry Watkins elected Society representatives for FEF TDA.
- 5/3/97 — Governing Committee Meeting — Aptos
  - New members added: Diana Elwin, Bob Fontana, Christine Hutchins, Claire Myers, Mark Turrin
  - New officers elected
  - Annual membership dues established at \$12
  - Society web site established at <http://www.UrantiaGGC.org>
  - Suggested: an annual outreach party to include people from outside the movement; worship services, discussion of UB; workshop on dealing with media.
- 6/29/97 — Governing Committee Meeting
  - Dues solicitations to be included in Developments
  - Retreats are to be self-sustaining.
  - Program Ad Hoc Committee becomes an official Committee
  - Program Committee members to be reimbursed for expenses
  - Decided: to update the GGC Constitution
  - Decided: that Nora Abdemaokher is an employee of GGC under the supervision of the Governing Committee
  - Decided that Committee meetings will (or can) be handled via e-mail
  - Production of Developments given to Communications Committee
- 11/8/97 — Governing Committee Meeting — Larry Geise's home
  - Review and comments regarding proposed Constitution revisions.
  - Review revised budget.
  - Decided upon budget process: money to be accumulated in current year to fund the following year. Translation funds may have to be accumulated during same year funds are required.
- 11/8/97 — Semi-Annual Meeting — Larry Geise's home
  - New members added: Alan Douglas, Kim Terry, Terry McVey

- Updated Constitution voted upon and accepted.
  - Revised budget voted upon and accepted.
  - Ad Hoc Worship Committee established: Pat Fearey, Dave Holt, Dolores Nice, John Simonitch, Stephen Zendt. To develop monthly worship services.
- 4/17/98 — Semi-Annual Society Meeting
    - Discussion of ways to bring FEF and IUA members together.
    - Bob Fontana proposed quilt project for IC99
- 4/25/98 — Governing Committee Meeting
    - No official business transacted (shmoozed).
- 9/26/98 — Governing Committee Meeting
    - Jerry Pando has placed 180 Uversa Press Urantia Books locally and on Naval vessels.
    - \$200 set aside for Nora's translation friend in Bosnia
- 3/14/99 — Semi-Annual Society Meeting — Michelle Klimesh's home
    - Discussion: 100 Uversa Press books picked up from Jesusonian for distribution here after distribution program expired.
    - Decided: 100 Uversa Press books would be distributed from here rather than returning them to Jesusonian.
    - \$200 not paid to Nora's translation friend in Bosnia due to red tape.
    - Decided: people could become members without formal induction ceremony
    - Decided: Developments to be published once per year.
    - Ad Hoc Worship Committee discontinued.
    - Resolution: to bring GGC web site up-to-date
    - Mailing approved for full list regarding GGC/IUA dinner at Berkeley Marina.
    - Decided: Lee and Ilana's IC99 room and board and registration fees paid by GGC.
    - \$150 donated to FEF Family Life Committee in Chrissy's name
    - Quilt project committee established
- 8/21/99 — Governing Committee Meeting — Beth and Jerry Pando's home
    - Discussion of Nora Maokher's resignation from translation project.
    - Discussion and establishment of sequence for publication of Developments
