Camp Information

There is minimal privacy dormitory space for 50 persons and space for camping in tents or vehicles on the grounds (first come first serve basis). There are bathhouses equipped with toilets and showers. The camp has an outdoor chapel, an observatory, dining hall, basketball, volleyball, horseshoes and plenty of woods to explore. There is no room fee for infants and children under 12. Bring your own porta-cribs.

Meals: The Boulder Study Group will provide breakfasts for both mornings (Saturday and Sunday). We will provide a vegetarian dinner on Saturday (bring your own lunch), and we will provide a leftover lunch on Sunday. Bring your own food for snacks, etc.

Fees: There will be a \$3 cover charge per adult to cover miscellaneous expenses and to raise money for the treasury of the Boulder Study Group.
