We have chosen Burgdorf Hot Springs, 30 miles North of McCall for the 7th annual Conference of Idaho Students of The Urantia Book to be held the weekend of June 23-25th. We chose this historic location to gather our brothers and sisters in a rustic log cabin setting. Burgdorf Hot Springs has preserved its "turn of the century" flavor up to today. Surrounded by the Payette Nat'l Forest at an elevation of 6100 feet, you'll find the log-lined naturally heated pools, along with individual use cabins will provide us with an inspiring and enhancing environment.

Our "camping in a cabin" accommodations allow you a unique opportunity to experience life as it was with wood stoves, kerosene lamps, and even the traditional "outhouse." We also have available a National Forest campground a short walk from all activities. For those who prefer more modern lodgings, motels are available in McCall and you can enjoy the scenic 45 minute commute.

Burgdorf's remote setting excludes the use of electricity and we recommend your preparations include the items you normally take camping. We will be providing Saturday and Sunday brunch along with Saturday pizza and potluck-salad/dessert dinner. You may also wish to plan additional meals which can be prepared in your cabin or camp.
