
Moving the Camp to Pella

Lake Powell is located near Page, AZ on the AZ / Utah boarder approximately:

350 miles N. of Phoenix

525 miles S. of Salt Lake City

400 miles E. of Las Vegas

360 miles W. of Albuquerque

In other words, this is an out-of-the-way place for nearly everyone.

We will be leaving Wahweap Marina approximately noon on Friday, April 17, so allow plenty of time for traveling. Those that wish to serve as a boat captain will need to arrive the night before. The conference will end at noon on Sunday, April 19. GC Society will do everything to help with ground transportation to and from Flagstaff and Phoenix.

This is a high desert lake without a tree in sight, but the 2000 miles of coast, canyons, coves, buttes, vivid colors, and other geologic spectacles are awe-inspiring. We plan to set up headquarters in a private bay. The houseboats will take day trips along the lake and be beached in the evening. Each houseboat will be a floating study group. You might sleep on one boat but study on another.



During the public ministry of Jesus, camps at or near Pella became large gathering places for Jews & Gentiles alike. The idea of a large group of spiritually enthusiastic people camping together has inspired *Urantia Book* readers in Arizona to host this conference. The unique setting of living and studying on compact houseboats for 48 hours should stimulate us to higher level of cooperative sharing. 

JOIN US as we experience a little of the seaside camplife once lived by Jesus, the apostles and sincere truth seekers.






Things you should know



The daytime temperature can range from 50 - 70 degrees F. and the weather can be variable so we urge you to dress accordingly. Among the many logistical challenges in hosting a camping conference is the food. (Now we get an inkling of what Matthew, David and others experienced). We will prepare a simple menu ahead of time and divide it among the boats for the daytime meals and will barbecue for the evening meals. This will require participation from everyone so the boat captain might assign you to a cooking and clean-up team for at least one meal. Each boat comes equipped with propane heat, stove and fridge. You will need a "roughing it' attitude and your own sleeping bag and towels. Space and privacy are limited. There is no planned children's program. The adult program contains opportunities for youth to participate so instead of "baby-sitting" we are looking for a "child-sharing" frame of mind. The boats can hold 12 to 14 people with one bathroom.
