DEPOSIT: A deposit of \$200.00 per person is required to effect reservations, and balance of payment is required eight weeks prior to departure.

TOUR PRICE INCLUDES:

TRANSPORTATION: Economy class air transportation in accordance with the itinerary, based on the 6/60 day Advance Purchase Excursion Fare (APEX) which requires that tickets be fully paid and issued 14 days prior to departure. If you cancel after ticket is issued, \$50.00 of the fare will be forfeited, unless cancellation is caused by illness of the passenger or a member of his/her immediate family and inability to travel for this reason is supported by a certificate from a physician. After departure, no refund can be granted. If you change your travel plans enroute for any reason, you will be charged the new applicable fare which would have initially applied from your point of origin, less the fare paid for the special ticket.

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION: Private deluxe motorcoach in accordance with the itinerary, and by 1st class train Paris-Florence-Rome including seat reservations and supplements.

HOTELS: Accommodations will be provided in the first class hotels, as specified, or similar, and are based on two persons, sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath or shower.

MEALS: Israeli breakfast and table d'hôte dinner daily in Israel. Continental breakfast daily in Paris and Italy.

SIGHTSEEING: Sightseeing program, as specified in the itinerary, will be provided by motorcoach or other local conveyance, and services of guide-lecturers and entrance fees are included.

BAGGAGE: The tour price includes the handling of two suitcases per person. Passengers traveling by economy class air have a free baggage allowance of two checked cases not to exceed 44 lbs. in weight, and total combined dimensions limited to 106 inches (length and height and width), provided neither bag exceeds 62 inches. A complimentary I.G.S. overnight bag will be provided which, if taken, must be cared for by the traveler at all times. Baggage insurance is recommended and can be furnished at nominal rates.
