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FINAL ITINERARY

ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

Day 1, Thursday, August 11

Begin your exciting journey as you depart on board your overnight transatlantic flight to the Holy Land.

ARRIVE THE HOLY LAND

Day 2, Friday, August 12

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport where you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Bat-Yam.

BAT-YAM/CAESAREA/HAIFA/TIBERIAS

Day 3, Saturday, August 13

Drive north today to Caesarea to view the ruins of the Crusader's fortress and moat and sit in the great Roman amphitheatre. Continuing along the coast, you will see the aqueduct that carried water from Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. On to Megiddo, located on the Plain of Esdraelon. Visit the museum, ruins of the city and Solomon's Stables. Continue to Haifa, where you will ascend Mt. Carmel for a magnificent view of the sea and harbor. See the Carmelite Monastery and Elijah's Cave, as well as the Bahai Temple with its lovely Persian Gardens. Proceed to Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar.

TIBERIAS

Day 4, Sunday, August 14

This morning board a motorcoach and cross the blue water of Galilee to Capernaum, the village Jesus called His "own city" after leaving Nazareth. Here you will see the remains of the second-century Synagogue and Peter's House. Driving along the shores of Galilee, you see the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the famous Sermon on the Mount and chose the twelve Apostles. Then continue to Tabgha, scene of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Balance of day at leisure.

TIBERIAS/SAFED/HAZOR/DAN RIVER/TIBERIAS

Day 5, Monday, August 15

Morning tour of the Golan Heights will include the city of Safed, the excavations of Hazor (capital of the Canaanites whom Joshua conquered), the Dan Spring, one of the three Tributaries of the Jordan River and Caesarea Philippi. Return to Tiberias for a free afternoon.

TIBERIAS

Day 6, Tuesday, August 16

Enjoy a day at leisure.

TIBERIAS/CANA/NAZARETH/JERUSALEM

Day 7, Wednesday, August 17

This morning drive to Cana, to visit the Church which commemorates the first miracle of our Lord Jesus when He turned water into wine at the wedding, and continue to Nazareth, the Village of Mary and Joseph and the home of Jesus until the beginning of His public ministry. Visit the Church of the Annunciation, the Grotto assumed to be Joseph's carpenter shop, and the Virgin Spring; and after a short walk in the Old City, visit the synagogue. View Mt. Tabor, and then on to Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

Day 8, Thursday, August 18

This morning proceed on a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Enter St. Stephen's Gate. Visit St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the crippled man. Continue to the Temple Area. See the Dome of the Rock, the El Aqsa Mosque and the Wailing Wall. Exit via the Dung Gate to St. Peter's in Gallicantu. View the Valley of Gehenna and the Pool of Siloam.

This afternoon enter Herod's gate to the Roman Praetorium, beneath the Sister of Zion Convent, and the Ecce Homo Arch. Follow in the footsteps of Jesus as you walk the Via Dolorosa, the traditional way of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Leave the Old City through the Damascus Gate. End your inspiring visit at the Garden Tomb, believed by many to be Golgotha.

JERUSALEM

Day 9, Friday, August 19

This morning drive to Bethany to visit Lazarus' Tomb and the village of Mary and Martha. Then on to Biblical Jericho, believed to be the oldest city in the world. View Elisha's Spring and the Mount of Temptations. Continue to the Dead Sea, 1288 feet below sea level, site of ancient Sodom and Gomorrah. Stop at the Caves of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered and visit the excavations. On the east side of the Dead Sea are the Moab Mountains and Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Continue to the citadel stronghold of Masada. Ascend by cable car to the fortress where 967 Zealots made their last stand against Rome in 73 A.D.

JERUSALEM

Day 10, Saturday, August 20

Enjoy a day at leisure in Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

Day 11, Sunday, August 21

This morning drive to Betlehem for church services. Then visit the Church of the Nativity and see the manger where Jesus was born and Shepherd's field. Time to shop for wood carvings before driving to Mt. Zion to see the Upper Room, traditional site of the Last Supper. Visit the Church of All Nations on the Rock of Agony before continuing to Mt. Olivet to the Garden of Gethsemane and walk along the ancient olive trees, viewing the Kidron Valley. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension and the Church of Pater Noster enroute to your hotel.

JERUSALEM/LONDON

Day 12, Monday, August 22

This afternoon transfer to the airport to board your flight departing to London where you will overnight.

LONDON/NEW YORK

Day 13, Tuesday, August 23

Your exciting visit to the Holy Land is over as you board your return flight to New York arriving the same day.



7-DAY EGYPT POST TOUR EXTENSION

JERUSALEM/BEN GURION AIRPORT/CAIRO

Day 12, Monday, August 22

Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport to board your flight departing to Cairo. Upon arrival Cairo Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

CAIRO

Day 13, Tuesday, August 23

This morning visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, housing the magnificent treasures of Tut-Ankh-Ahmon. Then on to Giza to view the Great Pyramids and the Sphinx, sole survivors of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. In the afternoon, visit Old Cairo. See the Hanging Church and the Coptic Museum. Continue to the Citadel Fortress erected by Salah-ed-Din in the 12th Century. See the Alabaster Mosque and the Sultan Hassan Mosque. Stroll through the winding streets of Khan-el-Khalili bazaar where artisans and merchants have traded for centuries.

CAIRO/MEMPHIS/SAKKARA/CAIRO

Day 14, Wednesday, August 24

Breakfast is followed by a driving tour to Memphis and a visit to the ruins of the Temple of Ptah, the Alabaster Sphinx of Ramses II. Then tour the fourth Dynasty Pyramids of King Unas of Sakkara, Tombs of the Nobles, Serapeum. Return to your hotel in Cairo. Balance of day is free.

CAIRO/LUXOR

Day 15, Thursday, August 25

Morning flight to Luxor. Upon arrival immediately start your sightseeing tour. Cross the Nile River by ferry boat to the West Bank for a visit to the Thebes Necropolis. Visit the

Valley of the Kings, at Medinet Habu and Ramesseum containing the tombs of the Tut-Ankh-Amon, Seti and Queen Nefertiti, Deir El Bahari and the Colossi of Memnon, and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Return by ferry boat to the East Bank where after a short rest you will visit the Temples of Karnak and Luxor. Included are the Temple of Amun-Ra in Luxor; in Karnak the Temples of Amun, Mut and Khons, Sacred Lake, Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut and Avenue of Ram Sphinxes.

LUXOR/ASWAN

Day 16, Friday, August 26

Morning flight to Aswan. Upon arrival begin your sightseeing with a visit to Philae Island by sailboat. You will see many ancient monuments, including the Temple of Isis. After a rest your afternoon sightseeing tour begins with a visit to the Granite Quarries and the unfinished Obelisk, the New High Dam and Lake Nasser, the old Aswan dam and the Aswan Museum. By means of a Felucca sailboat, cross one of the tributaries of the Nile to visit the Mausoleum of Agha Khan and the sixth-century Monastery of St. Simeon across the desert.

ASWAN/CAIRO

Day 17, Saturday, August 27

Transfer to airport to board your flight returning to Cairo.

CAIRO/NEW YORK

Day 18, Sunday, August 28

Homeward bound flight with many unforgettable memories.
