FUNDAMENTALS OF THE URANTIA PAPERS

PART ONE, DEFINITIVE

1.. COSMOGRAPHY

This outline deals with cosmography -- the geography of the cosmos; other presentations will consider its origin (cosmogony) and its character (cosmology).

DEFINITIONS:

Cosmography: "A general description of the world or of the universe; or the science which teaches the constitution of the whole system of worlds, or the figure, disposition, and relation of all its parts." -- Webster.

Cosmology: "That branch of metaphysics which treats of the character of the universe as an orderly system or cosmos; also a treatise relating to the structure and parts of the world system." -- Webster.

Cosmogony: "1. The creation, origination, or manner of coming into being, of the world or universe. 2. A theory or account of the origination of the universe; also such theories considered as a department of knowledge." -- Webster.

"Your world, Urantia, is one of many similar inhabited planets which comprise the local universe of Nebadon. This universe, together with similar creations, makes up the superuniverse of Orvonton ... Orvonton is one of the seven evolutionary superuniverses of time and space which circle the never-beginning, never-ending creation of divine perfection -- the Central Universe of Havona. At the heart of this Eternal and Central Universe is the stationary Isle of Paradise, the geographic center of infinity and the dwelling place of the eternal God.

"The seven evolving superuniverses in association with the Central and Divine Universe, we commonly refer to as the Grand Universe; these are the now organized and inhabited creations. They are all a part of the Master Universe which also embraces the uninhabited but mobilizing universes of outer space." (F:0:5 & 6)

SCHEME OF PRESENTATION: Data have been grouped under four headings --

1. The Cosmos
2. The Isle of Paradise
3. The Master Universe
4. The Grand Universe

I. THE COSMOS


Cosmos is defined as "the universe conceived as an orderly and harmonious system -- contrasted with chaos." -- Webster.

- A. The Isle of Paradise "...is motionless being the only stationary thing in the universe of universes. ... [it] has a universe location but no position in space." (F:IV:12) "Space does not touch Paradise; only the quiescent midspace zones come in contact with the central Isle." (11:7:1)
- B. The Midspace Zones. "Paradise is the actually motionless nucleus of the relatively quiescent zones existing between pervaded and unpervaded space. Geographically these zones appear to be a relative extension of Paradise but there probably is some motion in them. (11:7:2) "These ... zones eventually encompass the borders of all space." (11:7:3)
- C. Space -- Pervaded and Unpervaded. "The vertical cross section of total space would slightly resemble a maltese cross, with the horizontal arms representing pervaded (universe) space and the vertical arms representing unpervaded (reservoir) space. The areas between the four arms would separate them somewhat as the midspace zones separate pervaded and unpervaded space." (11:7:3)
 - 1. Pervaded Space -- the horizontal extension around peripheral Paradise.
 - a. The Master Universe -- creation: actual & potential.
 - (1) The six space levels (Havona + Superuniverses + 4 Outer)
 - (2) The semi-quiet zones between the space levels.
(Once similar to midspace zones; now less quiescent.)
 - b. Space beyond the borders of the Master Universe.
 - 2. Unpervaded Space -- the vertical extensions above and below Paradise.
"Unpervaded space' means: unpervaded by those forces, energies, powers, and presences known to exist in pervaded space. ... In attempting to imagine ... these space reservoirs, you might think of an hourglass." (11:6:1-3)
- D. Motion -- of Space...contains and conditions motion. It even moves. Space and in space motions may be roughly classified as follows": (12:4:5)
 - 1. Primary motion -- space respiration -- the motion of space.
 - 2. Secondary motion -- alternate swings of space levels.
 - 3. Relative motions -- do not have Paradise base point.
 - 4. Compensatory motion correlating all other motions.



II. THE ISLE OF PARADISE

"Paradise is the eternal center of the Universe..." (11:0:1)

Dimensions: Paradise is non-spherical -- ellipsoid & flat. If east-west = Unity: North-south = 7/6 East-West; and Up-down = 1/10th East-West, The Central Isle therefore has three sides -- (1) Upper, (2) Periphery, and (3) Nether.

A. Upper Paradise.

1. The Deity Presence -- Father, Son and Spirit
2. The Most Holy Sphere -- worship, trinitization, spiritual attainment
3. The Holy Area -- the residential sectors

B. Periphery: Transport arrival and dispatching fields
 Force-focal headquarters for the Master Spirits
 Historic-Prophetic exhibit areas of local universes

C. Nether Paradise

1. In the central portion -- the Zone of Infinity (unknown & unrevealed)
2. Surrounding this zone -- an unnamed area
3. In the outer margins -- the Paradise force center (tri-concentric)
 - a. Inner zone -- focal point of the functions of Paradise itself.
 - b. Mid-zone -- unknown functions
 - c. Outer zone -- central focalization of the Unqualified Absolute.

III. THE MASTER UNIVERSE

- A. "The Paradise-Havona System, the eternal universe encircling the Eternal Isle, constitutes the perfect and eternal nucleus of the Master Universe...the superuniverses and all regions of outer space revolve...around [this] gigantic central aggregation..." (12:1:5)
- B. "The Grand Universe is the present organized and inhabited creation. It consists of the seven superuniverses with [a] ... potential of seven trillion inhabited planets... [and] the eternal spheres of the central creation." (12:1:7)
- C. The Outer Space Levels. "...the energy and matter of these outer and uncharted regions already equal many times the total...embraced in all seven superuniverses." (12:2:4)

1st Outer Level -- 400,000 lt-yrs distant; 25 million across.

2nd Outer Level -- 50 million lt-yrs beyond "still greater activities."

3rd Outer Level -- beginning to manifest directional trend.


4th Outer Level -- no mention of phenomena.


A. Upper Paradise

Top view; looking down.




B. Peripheral Paradise

Side view; looking inward.





The Seven Superuniverses as Dependent on Havona
The Organized and Inhabited Creation

A. The Central and Divine Universe

"This never-beginning, never-ending universe consists of one billion spheres of sublime perfection and is surrounded by the enormous dark gravity bodies. At the center of Havona is the stationary and absolutely stabilized Isle of Paradise, surrounded by its twenty-one satellites." (12:1:4) "Physically regarded, the Havona and the Paradise circuits are all one and the same system..." (14:1:10)

1. The Paradise Circuits. The 21 Sacred Spheres of Paradise; enormous physical spheres arranged in 3 circuits. "Each circuit is diverse in material, and each world...is different excepting the seven worlds of the Son, which are alike in physical constitution." (13:0:2) "These twenty-one spheres embrace the potentials of the function of the master universe." (13:0:7)

b. Mid-circuit -- The seven worlds of the Son. These "are the worlds of the seven phases of pure spirit existence." (13:3:1)

c. Outer-circuit -- The seven worlds of the Spirit. "...the Paradise headquarters of the seven superuniverses..." (13:4:6)

2. The Havona Circuits. "This is the...only settled, perfect, and established aggregation of worlds. This is a wholly created and perfect universe; it is not an evolutionary development." (14:0:2) "The billion worlds of Havona are arranged in seven concentric circuits immediately surrounding the three circuits of Paradise satellites. There are upwards of 35 million worlds in the innermost circuit and over 245 million in the outermost..." (14:1:9) "The...circuits are not superimposed..." (14:1:10) The Havona worlds are enormous material (triata) spheres.

3. The Dark Gravity Bodies. Out beyond the seventh Havona Circuit are the dark gravity bodies. They "...render the central universe a physically balanced and perfectly stabilized creation." (14:1:15) Because of their enormous mass "...the mass content of this central creation is far in excess of the total known mass of all seven sectors of the grand universe." (12:1:4) There are two circuits separated by a unique space intrusion. The inner circuit is tubular, consisting of three concentric-circular groupings. The outer circuit is perpendicular, being ten thousand times higher than the inner.

B. The Seven Superuniverses

"The first post-Havona creation was divided into seven stupendous segments..." (15:0:2) These "...seven superuniverses traverse a great ellipse...pursuing a definite...counter-clockwise course around the...central universe." (15:1:2)

The superuniverses are "...not primary physical organizations; nowhere do their boundaries divide a nebular family, neither do they cross a local universe, a prime creative unit. Each...is...a...space clustering of ...one-seventh of the organized...post-Havona creation." (12:1:6)

1. Orvonton "The vast Milky Way starry system represents the central nucleus of Orvonton... This great aggregation...forms a watchlike, elongated-circular grouping of about one-seventh of the inhabited evolutionary universes." (15:3:1) Orvonton is situated "...between superuniverses one and six, having not long since...turned the southeastern bend of the superuniverse space level... For untold ages Orvonton will pursue this...northerly course." (15:1:5)

Uversa. The capital of Orvonton, Uversa, is an architectural sphere. Such superuniverse capitals are "...independently lighted and heated. Each has a sun which gives forth light without heat...each is supplied with heat by the circulation of certain energy currents near the surface of the sphere. These...worlds (are) ...situated near the astronomical center of their respective superuniverses." (15:7:1) "Uversa...is immediately surrounded by the seven higher universities of advanced spiritual training... Each of those seven clusters...consists of seventy specialized worlds." (15:7:10)

2. Major Sectors "Ten major sectors...constitute a superuniverse." (15:2:8) "Of the ten major sectors of Orvonton, eight have been roughly identified by Urantian astronomers." (15:3:4) "...the ten major sectors...(whirl)...about the Uversa headquarters of Orvonton." (15:3:13)

Umajor V "Umajor the fifth, the headquarters of your major sector, Splandon, is surrounded by the seventy spheres of the advancing intellectual training of the superuniverse. (15:7:9)


3. Minor Sectors "One hundred minor sectors...make one major sector." (15:2:7) The one hundred minor sectors of Splandon all rotate about their major sector. "The rotational center of your minor sector is situated...in the...star cloud of Sagittarius, around which your local universe and its associated creations all move." (15:3:5)

Uminor III "Uminor the third, the headquarters of your minor sector of Ensa, is surrounded by the seven spheres of the higher physical studies of the ascendant life." (15:7:8)

C. The Local Universes

"One hundred local universes...constitute a minor sector..." (15:2:6) They all swing around their minor sectors, which revolve around the major sectors, which revolve around Uversa. "The local universes are in closer proximity as they approach Havona; the circuits are greater in number, and there is increased superimposition, layer upon layer. But farther out---there are fewer and fewer..." (15:3:16)

1. Nebadon The local universe of Nebadon"...is now well out towards the edge of Orvonton...far to the south and east in the superuniverse circuit." (32:2:11) The mass materialization of our local universe swings around the composite rotation-gravity center of the star cloud of Nebadon.

Salvington "Salvington, the headquarters of Nebadon, is situated at the exact energy-mass center of the local universe." (32:2:4) It is "...surrounded by 10 university clusters of 49 spheres each." (15:7:7)

2. Constellations "One hundred constellations constitute a local universe." (15:2:5) Our constellation "Norlatiadek...is now traversing the outer fringe of Nebadon." (41:10:5)

Edentia Our constellation headquarters is "...a cluster of 771 architectural spheres, the centermost and largest of which is Edentia... approximately 100 times as large as your world. The 70 major spheres surrounding Edentia are about 10 times the size of Urantia, while the 10 satellites which revolve around each of these 70 worlds are about the size of Urantia." (43:0:2)

3. Systems "One hundred systems...make up a constellation." (15:2:4) Our system, Satania "...is one of 100 local systems which make up... the constellation of Norlatiadek... Satania, itself, is composed of over 7,000 astronomical groups or physical systems..." (41:2:1,2) "Satania...is next to the outermost system of Norlatiadek..." (41:10:5)

Jersem The capital of Satania "...is almost 100 times the size of Urantia ... Jerusem's major satellites are the 7 transition worlds, each of which is about 10 times as large as Urantia, while the 7 subsatellites of these transition spheres are just about the size of Urantia. The 7 mansion worlds are the 7 subsatellites of transition world number one." (45:0:1,2)

4. Inhabited Worlds "All inhabited worlds are basically grouped...into the local systems, and each of these local systems is limited to about one thousand evolutionary worlds." (49:0:2) "Satania...is an unfinished system containing only 619 inhabited worlds. Such planets are numbered serially in accordance with their registration as inhabited worlds..." (49:0:3)

Urantia Our world is Number 606 of Satania. "Urantia is comparatively isolated...your solar system, with one exception, being the farthest removed from Jerusem..." (41:10:5)






THE FAMILY TREE OF -





"...in the universes of time and space the Father is not discernably absolute as total Deity except in the Paradise Trinity." (10:3:8)

"In his contact with the post-Havona creations, the Universal Father does not exercise his infinite power and final authority by direct transmittal but through his Sons...and God does all this of his own free will." (3:5:1)

2. Superuniverse Administration

"As far as the Paradise Trinity is concerned outside Havona, there are just seven inhabited universes, the seven superuniverses which hold jurisdiction over the first post-Havona space level." (15:0:1)

3. Administrative Co-ordination

"The seven groups of Supreme Spirits constitute the nucleus of the functional family of the Third Source and Center...they unify the descending administrative levels and co-ordinate the manifold functions of the personnel thereto." (17:8:1)

4. Local Universe Administration

"As far as the Eternal Son and the Infinite Spirit are concerned the universes are localized...under the joint rule of the Creator Sons and the Creative Spirits." (15:0:1)

5. Universal Overcontrol

"...who fosters and cares for the fundamental needs of the Master Universe as a whole, from Paradise to the fourth and outermost space level? Existentially such overcare is probably attributable to the Paradise Trinity." (12:6:8)

I. GRAND UNIVERSE ADMINISTRATION (NOTES)

There are five essentially distinct but perfectly correlated lines of administrative authority in the grand universe:

A. The Paradise Trinity.

While this line of authority bifurcates through the order of Days and the Master Spirits, the latter are separately considered. Note that the order of Days embrace three levels of direct sovereignty:

1. Trinitized Secrets of Supremacy on the Father's Worlds.
2. Eternals of Days on the billion worlds of Havona.
3. Ancients of Days, rulers of the superuniverses.

While the orders of Days on sub-Orvonton levels are directly representative of the Trinity, they are administratively responsible to the Ancients of Days.

B. The 7 Master Spirits.

1. Direct administration: in Havona, the Circuit Spirits; in Orvonton, the Reflective Spirits and the Ancients of Days.
2. Indirect administration: the Creative Spirits are, by nature like the Master Spirit of superuniverse jurisdiction.
3. The Supreme Executives (board of managers for the Master Spirits) maintain administrative contact with all levels.

C. The Infinite Spirit.

This line of administrative authority intersects that of the Master Spirits in Havona (Circuit Spirits) but has its principal expression in the Creative Spirits of the local universes.


D. The Father-Son.

This is a direct line of administration extending straight out from Paradise to the Creator Sons of the local universe being otherwise unaffiliated with grand universe administration.


E. The Son-Spirit.




