I. Description of the total cosmos.

A. Paradise -- the geographic center of infinity.

B. Space -- a bestowal of Paradise.

C. Cross section of total space -- pervaded, unpervaded, mid-space.

1. Slightly resembles a maltese cross.



2. Pervaded space -- volume described by a large V shaped plane in elliptical revolution about Paradise. Contained herein are six space levels: the Central Universe, the Super Universe and four outer space levels, interspersed by semi-quiet zones.

3. Unpervaded space -- space reservoirs -- volume outline resembles an hour glass.

4. Paradise is the motionless nucleus of mid-space, which geographically appears to be a relative extension of Paradise.

D. Space respiration -- a pulsating cosmos.

E. Horizontal cross section of pervaded space.

F. Architects of the Master Universe -- the living blue prints of the master universe.

II. Paradise

- A. Paradise, at the center of the universe of universes, is the most gigantic body in the master universe, a worthy capital of the universe of universes.
- B. Its shape - elliptical and flat.
- C. Its composition - single form of materialization - stationary, homogeneous organization of space potency, unique, not found elsewhere - called absolute^{um}.
- D. Upper Paradise
 1. Central area - ^{di}ety Presence
 2. Most holy sphere - high spiritual attainment, worship, trinitization.
 3. Outer region - Holy Area - seven concentric zones - residential region.
- E. Peripheral Paradise.
 1. Landing and dispatching fields.
 2. Force - focal headquarters of Seven Master Spirits.
 3. Historic and prophetic exhibits of Creator Sons.
- F. Nether Paradise.
 1. Central unknown and unrevealed Zone of Infinity.
 2. Unnamed area.
 3. Outer margin consisting of three concentric elliptical zones - concerned with space potency and force energy.
 - a. Inner zone - functions as a gigantic heart whose pulsations direct and modify force-energies.
 - b. Mid-zone - pulsating control mechanism of midspace or quiet zones.
- related to nonpervaded-space mechanism of the master universe.
 - c. Outer zone - central focalization of the space presence of the Unqualified Absolute.
- central circuit point of emanations of space-force pulsating in 2-billion year cycles in synchrony with space respiration.
- source and destiny of all force-energy.

III. The Central Universe.

A. The Sacred Worlds of Paradise - three seven-world circuits of the Father, Son and Spirit - enormous, unique, eternal.

1. Seven secret spheres of the Universal Father.
2. Seven luminous worlds of the Eternal Son.
3. Seven immense spheres of the Infinite Spirit.

B. Havona.

1. Arrangement - seven concentric circuits not superimposed.

The billion worlds of Havona are arranged in seven concentric circuits immediately surrounding the three circuits of Paradise satellites. There are upwards of thirty-five million worlds in the innermost Havona circuit and over two hundred and forty-five million in the outermost, with proportionate numbers intervening. Each circuit differs, but all are perfectly balanced and exquisitely organized, and each is pervaded by a specialized representation of the Infinite Spirit, one of the Seven Spirits of the Circuits. In addition to other functions this impersonal Spirit co-ordinates the conduct of celestial affairs throughout each circuit.

The Havona planetary circuits are not superimposed; their worlds follow each other in an orderly linear procession. The central universe whirls around the stationary Isle of Paradise in one vast plane, consisting of ten concentric stabilized units - the three circuits of Paradise spheres and the seven circuits of Havona worlds. Physically regarded, the Havona and the Paradise circuits are all one and the same system; their separation is in recognition of functional and administrative segregation.

D. Dark gravity bodies.

1. Far out, an unbelievable number, enormous, unique, enshroud Havona.
2. Two equal circuits, revolve in opposite directions, the inner tubular, the outer perpendicular, longer and narrower.

IV. The Seven Superuniverses

A. The grand universe - the present organized and inhabited creations - embraces the central creation and the seven superuniverses, thus including one billion worlds of Havona, a potential of seven trillion inhabited planets and almost half a trillion architectural worlds.





Suggested Configuration of Headquarters Worlds.


SUPERUNIVERSE - 491 - Capital surrounded by 7 clusters of 70 worlds each.




MAJOR SECTOR - 71 - Capital surrounded by 70 spheres.



MINOR SECTOR - 8 - Capital surrounded by 7 spheres.




LOCAL UNIVERSE - 491 - Capital surrounded by 70 primary spheres in 10 groups, each surrounded by 6 tributary spheres.



(Nine more groups of 49 worlds)




CONSTELLATION - 771 - Capital

VI. Evolution of Nebadon.

- A. Almost a trillion years ago an associate force organizer reported space conditions favorable for initiation of materialization. 87 billion years later the Ancients of Days authorized the organization of a new material creation.
- B. 875 billion years ago (25 billion years later) the Andronover nebula was initiated.
- C. 600 billion years ago the height of the Andronover energy - mobilization was attained - it was a gigantic circular gas cloud.
- D. 500 billion years ago the first sun was born, and streaked away. Many more followed.
- E. 400 billion years ago the recapture period began. Michael began creation of the universe of Nebadon. Architectural worlds of Salvington and 100 constellation headquarters worlds were begun.
- F. 300 billion years ago Michael's staff arrived. Nebadon was given physical recognition by Uversa government.
- G. 200 billion years ago life was implanted. Nebadon was registered as a universe of inhabitation and progressive mortal ascension.
- H. 100 billion years ago the height of tension was reached - heat was winning over gravity. Final sun dispersion begins.
- I. 50 billion years ago the period of sun dispersion was completed.
- J. 25 billion years ago relative stabilization was attained.
- K. 8 billion years ago the terminal eruption began.
- L. 6 billion years ago marked the birth of our sun, fifty-sixth from the last of the Andronover solar family.
- M. Total number of suns and sun systems having origin in the Andronover nebula was 1,013,628.
