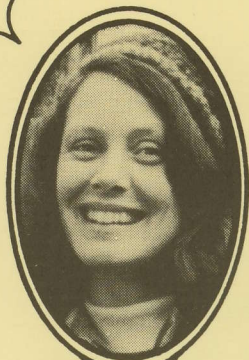

Singer, musician, songwriter, Sufi-dancing teacher, and storyteller; she plays guitar, fiddle and mandolin, and is the mother of one young son.



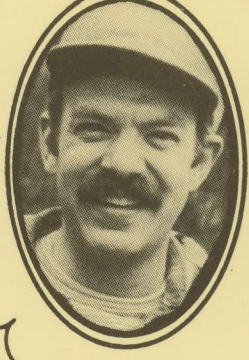
PATRICIA FEAREY

STEPHEN ZENDT

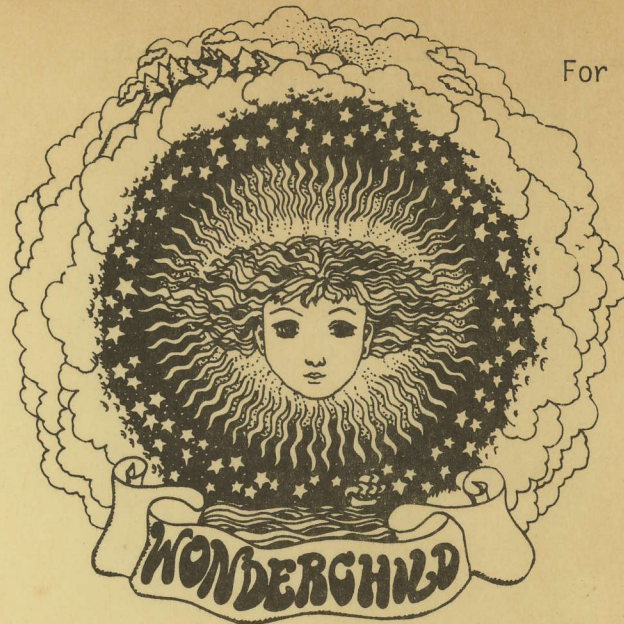
Narrator, actor, poet, writer and storyteller; he is our stage manager and production coordinator.
