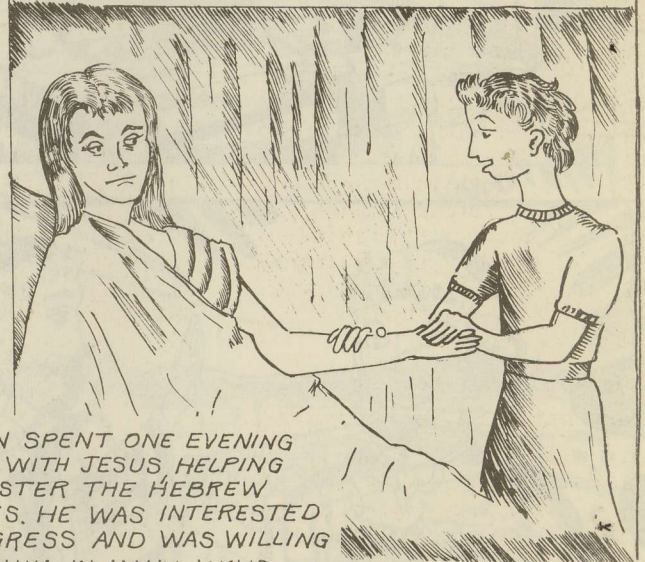


JESUS GREW. JUST BEFORE HE WAS

 SON. (P.1370)

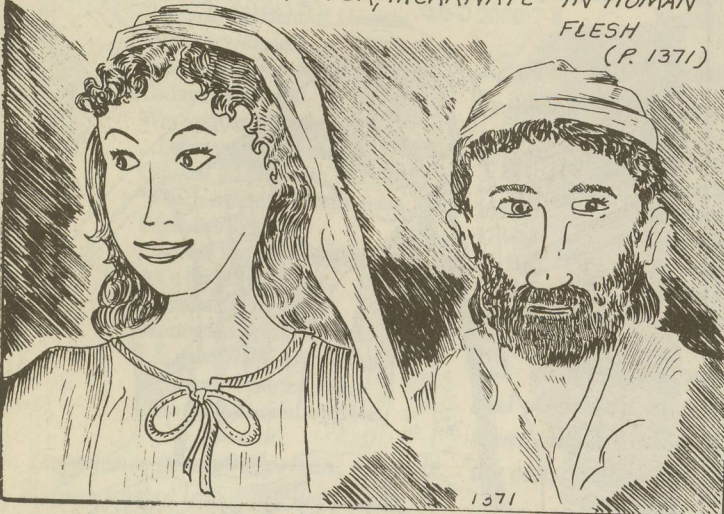


THE CHAZAN SPENT ONE EVENING

 UNDER THE RABBIS

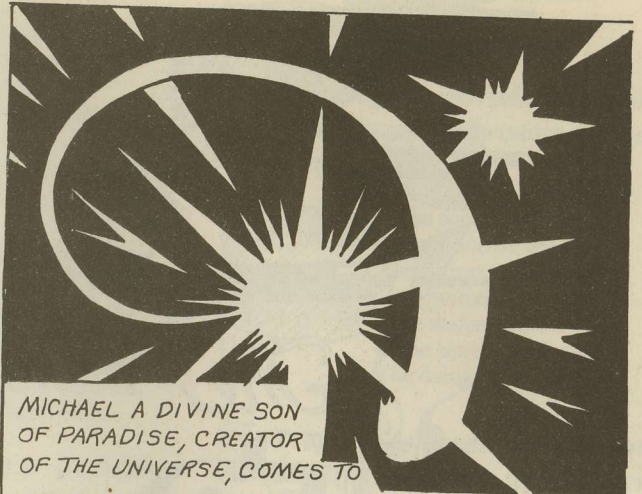

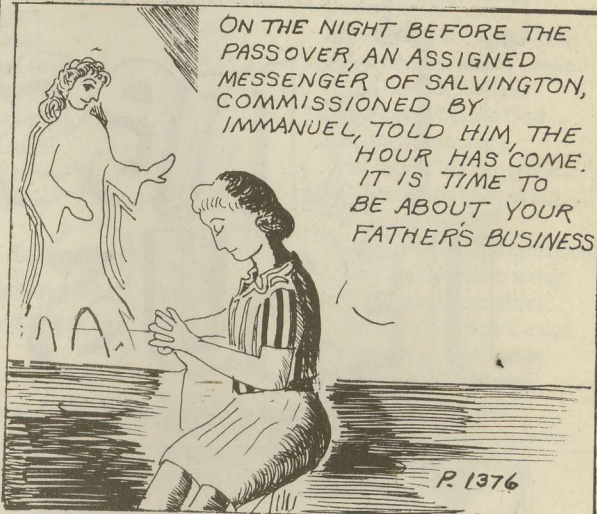

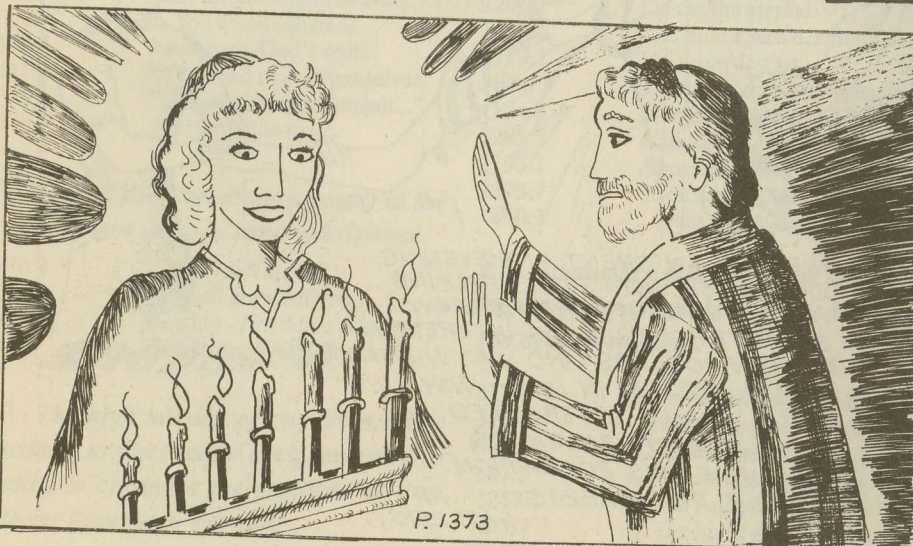
JESUS HELPED HIS FATHER IN THEIR SHOP AND LEARNED THE CARPENTER TRADE.

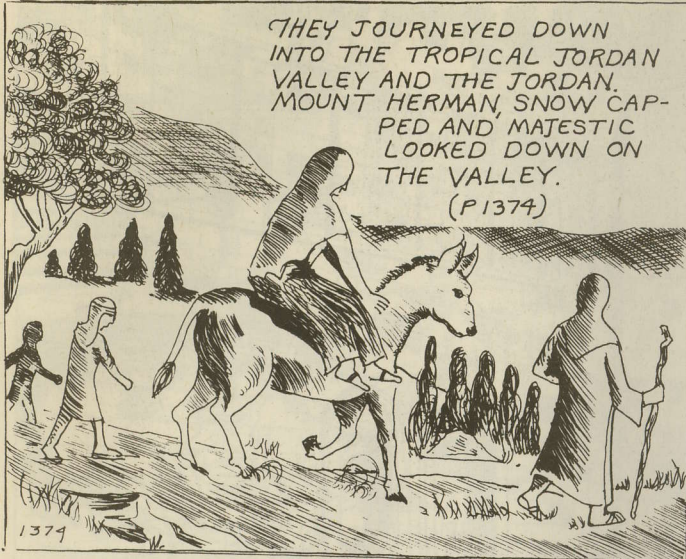

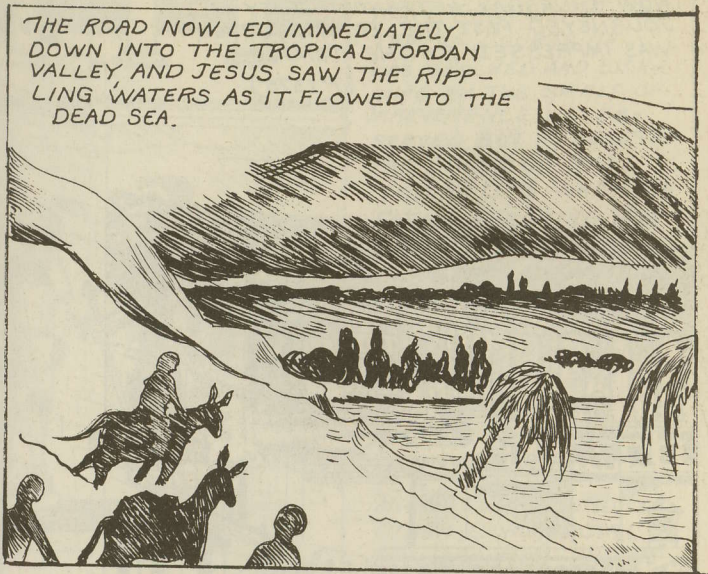

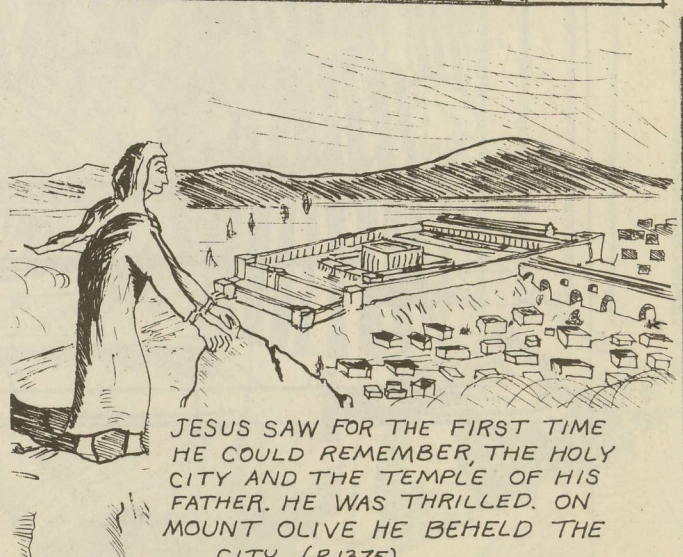


THEY CAME UPON A BUBBLING SPRING AND CAMPED FOR THE NIGHT UNDER THE STARS (P 1374)

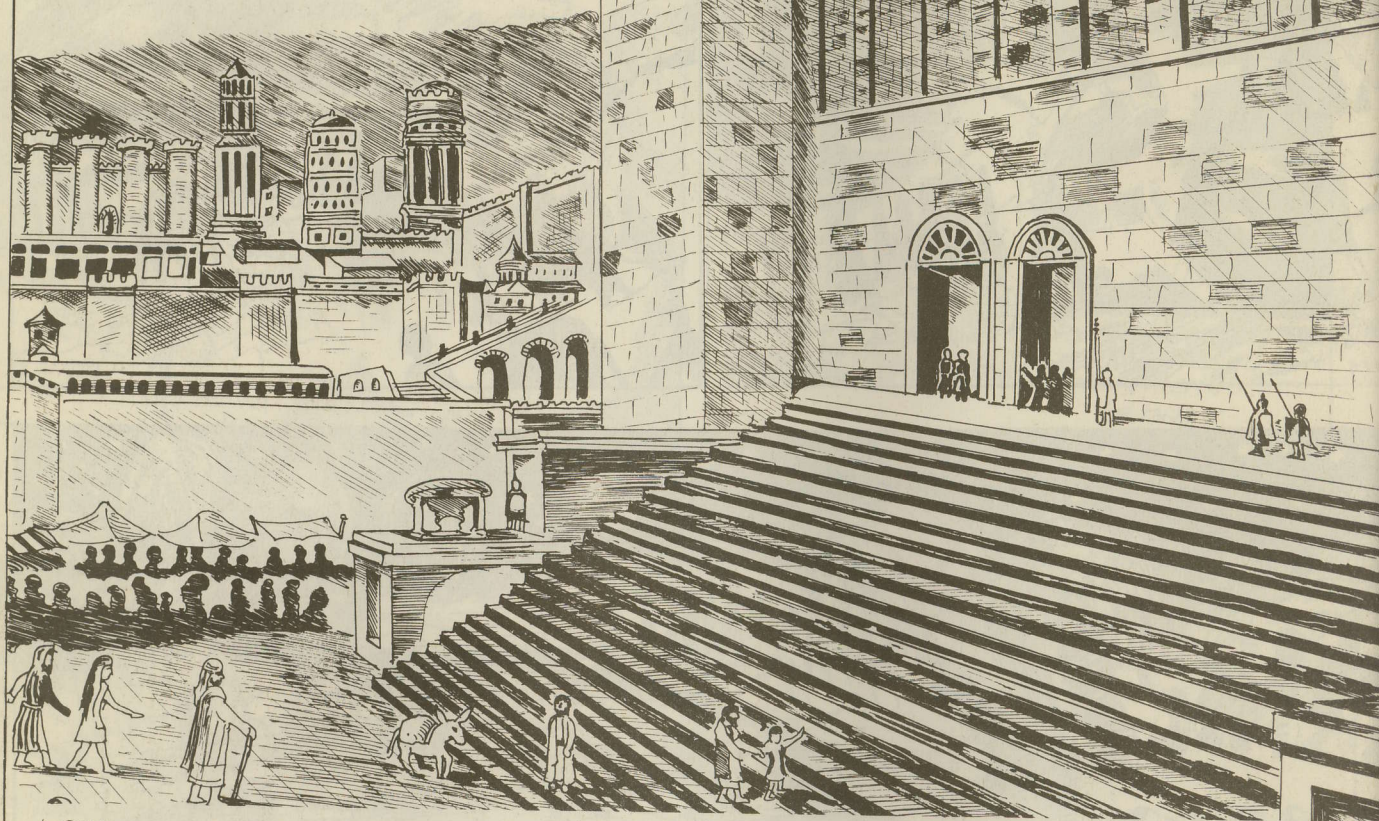

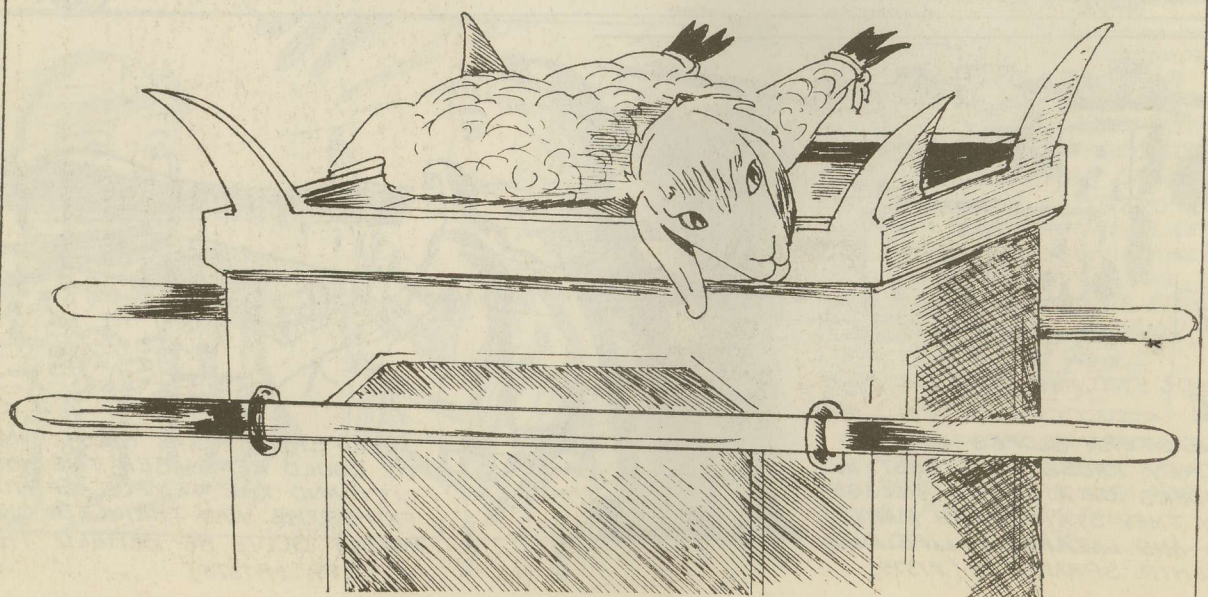


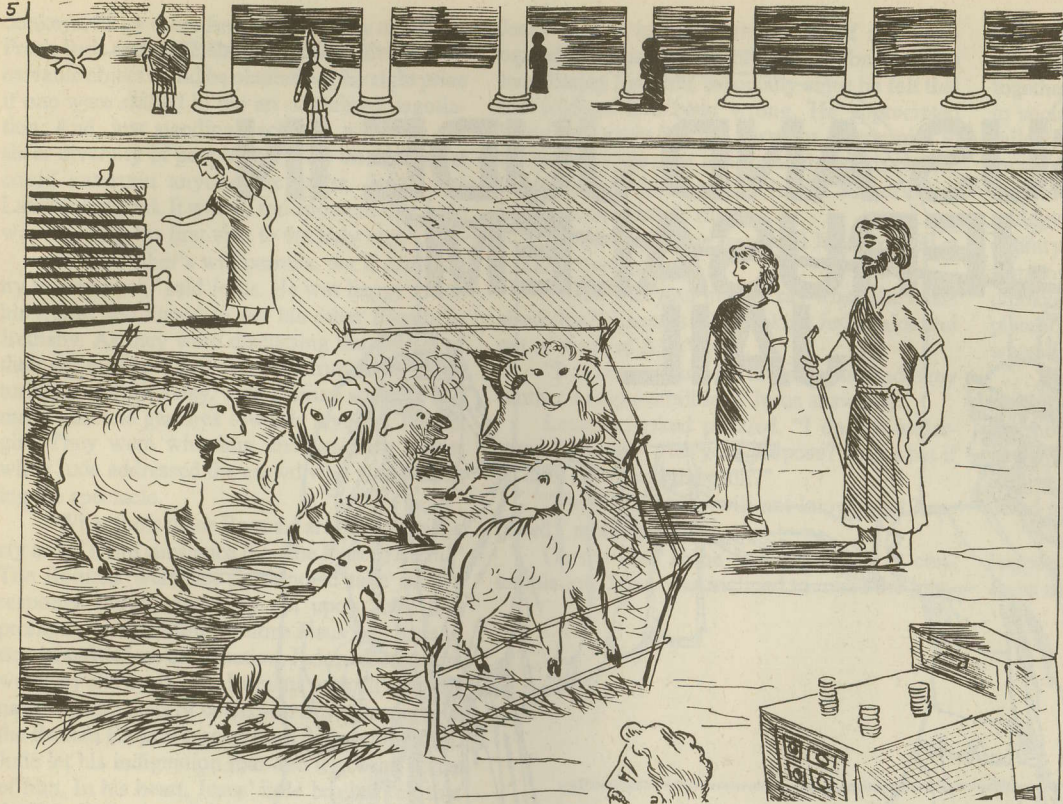
