Dear Dr. Sprunger

I was happy to get your note of December 31, 1956, and happy to hear that you are interested in distributing copies of the Urentia Book to key people.

Happily, at the present, I am able to assist you to a limited degree in your effort. I am having Miss Nola Smith (a Urentia member and friend of mine in Chicago) send you 7 copies of the Urentia Book at her earliest convenience. I ask, however, that you do not divulge my name to any recipients. I would, however, appreciate <sup>periodically</sup> hearing of their response. <sup>Kindly</sup> keep a file of responses.

There is no other "string" attached to the 7 copies. I do, however, have some advice.

— Unless you feel particularly impelled to do so, don't give the books away, but rather keep them as a sort of "circulating missionary library". Explain to the "Lovers" that they may keep the book as long as 7 months (2 months to read it—and 30 days to return it), but you would like the book returned so you can show it to others. As they may pay you for the book, so you can perpetuate the Library.

I do wish to emphasize that this advice is only a suggestion coming from my personal experience. I am sending the books to you as an outright gift to you to use as your spiritual prudence and foresight deem best.
