+ (By Associated Press.) +  
+ East St. Louis, Ill., Jan. 4.— +  
+ Wealthy persons soon will be +  
+ able to take mortgages on the +  
+ vital organs of others and have +  
+ them transplanted to their own +  
+ bodies in the place of defective +  
+ ones, according to a statement +  
+ made before the Wednesday +  
+ Club by Dr. William Sadler of +  
+ Chicago. +  
+ "We have not yet transplanted +  
+ human organs," Dr. Sadler said, +  
+ "but we have done this with +  
+ animals and the operations have +  
+ been successful. +  
+ "I do not believe it will be +  
+ long before wealthy men will be +  
+ able to take mortgages on the +  
+ kidneys and other organs of the +  
+ bodies of about forty laborers +  
+ under an arrangement made +  
+ whereby if one of these men +  
+ with perfect organs is killed ac- +  
+ cidentally their organs go to the +  
+ person holding the option on +  
+ them." +
