They said it looks like the one <u>Leavening Our Religious Heritage lalsoyby Drssprunger</u>, also sent out by Chicago. I think the one sent out by Chicago is 8½ x 11 and an entirely different statement but I have no way to know for sure, so I say nothing.

However I do question two statements and I want your opinion. I have marked them in red pen. Of course I do NOT want to make a thing of it, I simply am curcious to see if somehow my memory is wrong though I doubt it.

1. Our Forum was NOT in communication with the revelators as far as I knew. Only about 8 or 10 people were and they were the contact commissioners. Dr. Sadler, Dr Lena, Will and Auntie Kellogg, Christy, later Bill Sadler, Dr and Mrs Case. Dr had told me this much. None of it makes much difference I guess and better not discussed.

2. How could that date be 1939? Of course Dr Sprunger had access to records etc as

President but I thought it was a little later, I came in in late 1939 and I was there a

while before Dr. Sadler issued that invitation to come on a Wed night and I came on a snowy

cold night and there were 70 of us and I was # 17. What was your number? It seemed to me

that had to be about 1940 but this I don't know for sure.

You are right about the things you marked. The group which met at 533 was not in communication with the revelators (only the contamttcommissioners). I'm sure the Seventy was not started in 1939- I think it was late in 1940. And I do not remember that Dr. Sadler was asked to start it or that the revelators had anything to do with directing it. But neither of these points matters very much, in my opinion.

I don't remember what my number was although I am sure there is a record of it somewhere.

What's Bud Kagan doing? We haven't heard from him for a long time and I bope we don't. I feel sorry for him, but there's not much we can do for him. h

You won't get this until abter Easter, but I hope you had a happy one. I'm leaving this noon to spend it at Kay's in Barrington. I don't bhink we will be doing anything much, except maybe go to see On Golden Pond.

Christy is still alive, but no one knows why. Apparently she has an iron constitution. Helen is just back from her eye operation and seems to be getting long fairly well, although she doesn't know how much she will be able to see.
