Dear Doctor Sadler,

We, the undersigned members of the Forum, having met informally during this vacation period, have given thought to the approaching vital problems of book publication, organization of the Foundation, Brotherhood and Societies, and our expected individual and collective responsibilities in the participation therewith.

Because the work for which the Forum was originally organized or designated to serve has now been concluded and we are arrived at a new phase of service wherein possible public opinion identification with book and organization may occur as the order is received to publish and it is decided that the time is at hand for setting up Foundation, Brotherhood and Society, we feel that great care, consideration and planning should be given to this whole enterprise and that the following questions should be debated, analyzed and answered to the satisfaction of all.

1. Is it wise for the foundation to attempt to publish this book itself, or might it be more practical and profitable to affiliate with a publisher of established reputation and experience?

2. Is an organization designed to disseminate the truth advisable, or needless, if a new publishing plan is introduced capable of launching the book in a manner to bring it to the attention of all the people?

3. Should a new organization be interpreted by the public at large as a new religious sect? If so, would such an organization create more prejudicial harm than good in the attempted furtherance of this revelation?

The purpose of this letter is to ask that you grant us, the undersigned, an opportunity of presenting to all members of the Forum, at the first re-convened meeting, Sept. 15th, a statement of the points we feel we should be freely discussed to the end that we may participate, through the expression of our views and ideas, in the establishing of plans which, to the best of our combined human knowledge and experience, will serve the highest purposes in enabling the successful and most widespread and unprejudiced launching of the spiritual revelation contained in this book.

Since every Forum member should bear an equal sense of responsibility with respect to all future developments, we feel that each should be granted the chance to express himself fully on the imperative matters confronting us and that the time has now come when such consideration should be given.

If this suggestion is agreeable to you and your fellow contact commissioners, that the first re-convened meeting of the Forum, on Sept. 15th, be opened to free discussion on all phases of the book and organization project, will you please so advise us, addressing your letter to Clyde Bedell, not later than Friday, Sept. 4th.
