Dearest David & Sue:

I can't tell you how surprised and delighted I was to receive your sweet contribution to the work. You really backed your request for me to continue the work — with material substance. Thank you so much for your efforts to progress the work. I shall do all I can — if my Father so desires, and shall go bravely on having our studies printed — so long as we can keep them from being publicized as they have been in the past. They are getting a bit "tough" in Chicago.

My holidays were almost ruined by the news of the Urantia Brotherhood (?) and First Urantia Society (?) expelling Robert Burton. His wife taught the "First Society" since their inception, and participated in their seminars <sup>every year</sup>. Robert made several trips to Mexico to get the finest translators to translate the Urantia Book into Spanish. But the Chicago office wouldn't give him permission to print it — except in a deluxe copy — like ours to sell at \$20.00. Bob wanted a \$10.00 edition on "not so fine" paper. He reasoned that Mexicans can not afford \$20.00 bibles.

The last year's report (?) (financial) from Chicago was \$17,500 to the Foundation and \$13,985 to the Urantia Brotherhood. Nobody knows what the Foundation money is being used for. We get a rather loosely accounted report yearly from the Brotherhood — which <sup>this year</sup> was very brief — and included "other expenses \$845.00". Nothing was ever accounted for that was turned over to the

Foundation, Pat Burton is a lawyer and there were several other men who were wondering what was really going on. They talked it over for a year or two. But when it comes to doing something that takes spiritual guts - every body deserts you!! When the show-down came - Bob had to do it alone. He tried for a long time to get an appointment with the Foundation and after eight months - they agreed. In the meantime they knew what it was about and had plenty of time to prepare for his questioning.

He merely stated that the constitution declares that all moneys are to be accounted for by and to the members - of all societies.

They evidently couldn't take any investigation and decided to get him out. He is such an avid worker - so inspired - and works so hard - even to help Ruth in her teaching and classes.

The enclosed bulletin is <sup>copy</sup> from a husband + wife who were in Chicago for many years and are members of the "First U.S." there. I couldn't believe it and they said they simply didn't understand it.

But they also added that, lately they visited Chicago - (they now live in Dallas, Texas) and happened to look on the bulletin board and one bulletin had three or four pages. - on the third page was a note that "Christy had resigned from the foundation board one and a half years ago."

No one knew of this so-called resignation - even the members of their own society. <sup>there are five</sup> members - <sup>life-</sup> time.

This November the 18<sup>th</sup> ('72) we received a bulletin

from Chicago stating the <sup>5.</sup> budget for the Foundation is "817,500". — Budget for what? <sup>P.S. This is the first time we received any news of Foundation budget!</sup>

Bob Burton asked if the Foundation members were receiving salaries. He declared that members should be apprised of what the moneys are spent for. There has been no accounting.

They then declared no one was receiving salaries except someone who was doing secretarial work.

Bob has kept me informed about the situation and I presumed him (as an attorney) for not asking them — (the ~~same~~ (new/old) members of the board) if they were receiving money for expenses — if not salaries. (This is an old trick for covering up misspent funds)

I also think he should have given them a bit of a hard time by hiring an attorney to represent him. He can hardly speak above a whisper — as he had a throat operation a few years ago for a non-malignant tumor. He has passed his 90<sup>th</sup> birthday — and Ruth is 80. But he is a feisty old gentleman. <sup>(I don't even realize they will have to meet the Burtons on the mansion world very soon)</sup>

He may have started straightening them out by causing them to take an accounting of themselves — but — time will have to cure them.

Bob wrote me a few weeks ago and wanted to know why I asked them not to show the last paper (E.S.P.) to anyone. I merely stated that the new restrictions were too much — and we were now underground. He also asked if there was anything I wanted him to bring up at the questioning and I surate that I had had a rough enough time trying to straighten out the crooked roads in the Society out here. I sent two references 1547: #10: no 9 and 1566:5 to him as a guide line for the Foundation.

(By the way — the more I see of page 1567 the more I believe Judas was disintegrated.)

I tried so hard to get financial reports from the first source <sup>in L.A. group</sup> which the treasurer would not produce — the bank statements and the checks — an accounting. I too, was laughed at, Julia Fenderson and the every senile treasurer really kept the bank account empty.

There is always some way of proof of foul play. When I became Secretary to the Society I went through the records back to the beginning, since Julia had asked me to straighten them out. They were so mixed up it was unbelievable!

I re-filed them according to dates and happened to see a statement of \$67.00 to Georgia Gecht for charts — supposedly paid during the two years I had not attended any meetings. They have never paid for any of my work — until I was teaching the School of Meaning and Values in 1968 and 1969. They paid for two study outlines.

I am sorry — so sorry — to say (or think) that the secret resignation <sup>from the Foundation</sup> — just now discovered — not even announced — appears to be a legal nose-wiping — for protection of character — of this certain person.

After the disillusionment I have been through in the L.A. group — I can believe anything! My heart-break is not with the L.A. group, the Foundation, nor the so-named "Brotherhood" (?) but is just with this poor

old planet "Venus" <sup>5</sup>, no wonder we are the  
"talk of the town" in the cosmos. We may be  
on the "fringe" <sup>of the Superuniverse,</sup> and small and far-away, - but  
we have a universe reputation and as the  
book states, great ones come from afar to make  
a study of how the Luciferian rebellion is being  
humbled, and the progress we are making. I suppose  
they are now extrapolating our future - since  
we are the last of the lowest - including one  
or two other planets.

Well! since they tell us that Judas was  
a 'faith' adventure to Jesus <sup>1566: LP</sup> I guess we  
can say these organizations are "faith" adventures,  
for us. We must sit que up. God and Michael  
need you also to carry on the work.

I was aware of the Berkeley situation  
long ago - but I thought you would see it  
yourselves. <sup>(enclosed)</sup>

I am going to send a photo copy of  
a letter Bob Strait wrote to Christy lately  
and you may be surprised at the courage  
someone had to expose the situation up there.

I think the "info. exchange" you mentioned  
is an excellent idea - and even the name  
was exciting - "disenfranchised visionaries" - etc.  
How about "Supreme Freaks of the Catacombs"?

By the way the letter of B. Strait's is for  
your confidential file only. - (strictly for the  
inter-exchange secret luminaries (?)) (I wonder if  
I put my halo on straight today?)  
Barry Truman made a beautiful statement  
in his interview by Ed. R. Morrow. Morrow said

"Mr. Truman there has been a common saying  
"Give 'em hell, Harry!" what did you do to  
provoke that remark so often?" Harry said  
"I don't know, I just told the truth and they thought

I certainly appreciate your offering to  
carry on the concepts that I am trying to

certainly is interesting - and fun. Even though  
she is just a little five-circuited orphan,  
she is a member of the "Supreme Freaks". She is  
trying to 'unify' her stomach with the shrimps  
in the frigidarium. I da Belle hates her I think.

There is a seminar being planned to  
be held here in L.A. in June, I think. I  
don't intend going - for about six reasons  
which I will tell you about later - since  
it involves six people.
