

Dear Pat,

The Urantia-based FAMILY OF GOD radiocast is now heard every Sunday at 7 P.M. over the Los Angeles station XPRS (1090 on your dial). With powerful transmitters located in Mexico just across the California border, this station reaches 15 states and Western Canada with an audience of several million listeners, many of them searching for, and ready to accept, the teachings of Jesus -- the Fatherhood of God and the Brotherhood of man.

Each 15-minute Sunday night broadcast costs \$100 on station XPRS -- which is a tremendous value, considering the number of people reached. Vern Bennom Grimsley continually evangelizes the concepts of the Urantia Book on his FAMILY OF GOD broadcasts.

A new member of the First Urantia Society of Los Angeles last month wrote a check sufficient to provide air time through the month of December 1971 even though he is putting himself through school in the evenings. But unless additional contributions are received, the program will not be continued in January, or February, etc. It is urgent that contributions be made as soon as possible, because once this air time is lost for lack of funds, it will not be possible to regain it, since the station has a waiting list.

We are contributing, as a starter for 1972, enough to provide air time for one program. Scott Forsythe, vice president of the Los Angeles society, is doing the same. More help of this kind is needed right now. There is no source of funds to support this broadcast other than contributions from those of us who believe in its spiritual mission. You will receive a receipt and each gift is tax deductible.

As you know, the radiocast proclaims, as the Urantia Book teaches, that "That which the world needs most to know is: Men are the sons of God, and though faith they can actually realize, and daily experience, this ennobling truth" (p. 2052). The choice is ours this moment to keep this Urantia-based broadcast on this powerful station. May the Family of God Foundation hear from you?
