Dear Rich:


It was good to see you skiing on crutches up in Snowmass last week. I looked all over for you after that chance meeting in the rental shop, but to no avail. I must have written down your room number incorrectly.

As I mentioned, The Boulder School is now part of the Rocky Mountain URANTIA Society of Denver, which is a non-profit organization whose tax exempt qualifications I am enclosing with the letter. Our tax exempt status allows us to receive donations of less than \$5,000 from any one individual or company without jeopardizing our public exemption. We are, however, allowed to accept larger donations after filing for and receiving special permission. The School's projected annual operating budget is \$2,000 per month or \$24,000 per year. This includes approximately: 1) \$1,000 per month for a full-time secretary-administrator who works 40 hours a week; 2) \$8,000 a year as the cost of flying in and paying seminar instructors; 3) \$4,000 a year for office expenses, equipment rental, utilities, etc. The space for the School costs me \$13,500 per year, and I charge the School no rent or maintenance fees.

My goal is to find 5 people to donate \$4,800 per year each, and you are one of my prime candidates. You did mention that this would be no problem, and the School could certainly use the money soon.

Again, thank you for managing my \$100,000 in the commodities market; I do appreciate it greatly.


Dear Rich,
