Dear John;

John has asked me to send the Society Tithe Report along with the Boulder School documents that I had promised you. In addition to the reported funds, the Boulder School received \$5,005 in donations during the reported quarter. John said that the two of you had discussed the issue of tithing on these funds and that you had indicated that since the School was not a profit-making enterprise (Heaven knows), that a tithe would not be required. If I am in error on this point, please let me know. (John also sends his apologies for the delay of the report.)

The other enclosures all relate to the Boulder School. While you have seen earlier drafts of the Goals Statement and the Trustee structure, there have been some revisions of each, most importantly:

- 1) The Financial Goals section of the Goals Statement has been expanded to show in more detail the budgeted expenditures.
- 2) The inclusion of the Chairperson of the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee as a member of the Trustees for the term of his or her office.

The other documents are drafts of: 1) the Structure and Purpose of the Academic Advisory Board (of which the members of the URANTIA Brotherhood Education Committee will be ex-officio members), and 2) an outline of our Fundraising Program.


