The programs of the School are designed to aid the dissemination of the URANTIA teachings by helping to train committed leaders and teachers, and by undertaking various projects designed to foster the spiritual regeneration of Urantia and the promulgation of The URANTIA Book.

**The Student Program:**

The School's commitment to its students is: "To assist each student in preparing for whatever form or degree of ministry that he or she feels is consistent with the Heavenly Father's will." This preparation has three basic elements: 1) Personal Spiritual Growth; 2) Increased Knowledge; 3) Practical Experience. We have developed programs designed to foster progress in each of these areas and we are continually striving to improve these so that The Boulder School may more effectively assist the students in their efforts to increase their serviceableness to the Father.

The basic course of study is a two and one-half year program provided free-of-charge by the Rocky Mountain URANTIA Society of Denver. In lieu of tuition, each student is required to donate time to certain projects.

**The Service Projects:**

The Boulder School is serving those outside of the School through a number of projects underway and projected. For example:

- 1) Preparing and publishing various study aids and other materials designed to assist URANTIA Book study groups.
- 2) Assisting Clyde Bedell in the preparation of the next edition of his Concordex.
- 3) Assembling a national lending library of materials associated with The URANTIA Book.
- 4) Instituting a series of summer intensive courses for those who cannot attend the School full-time.
- 5) Assisting universities and colleges in their efforts to develop programs of study incorporating The URANTIA Book.
