The Rocky Mountain Urantia Society of Denver and the Boulder School are pleased to announce the following upcoming seminars, which you are cordially invited to attend.

April 11 & 12

"COSMOLOGY-COSMOSOPHY: THE SCIENCE OF THE NEW AGE" by
J.A. & Come Carpentier de Gourdon.

An exploration of the holistic synthesis of ancient wisdom with modern discoveries of physics, biology, astronomy and medicine. This seminar will cover a wide range of topics found in The URANTIA Book, but gleaned from evolutionary sources.

J.A. and COME CARPENTIER DE GOURDON are a father-son team, Come being educated by his father since his early childhood to view all major disciplines of knowledge as an indissoluble unity of complementary parts. From the age of twelve, Come has taught and lectured in over seventy universities and academic institutions of Europe, Asia (especially India), and America. Currently, Come is teaching and finishing up some graduate work at CU as well as preparing for publication a translation of a Nazarite manuscript of the gospel.

April 25 & 26

"THE LAND OF THE MASTER: ARCHEOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVES ON THE
TIMES OF JESUS" by David Kantor.

The URANTIA Book provides many provocative clues to locations in Israel where specific events associated with the Master's life took place. David and Sue Kantor have spent considerable time researching this topic, as well as traveling in Israel and photographing many of these locations. David will be sharing some of their slides and discussing archeology as related to the Jesus papers, as well as sharing an Inspirational multi-media program entitled, "Recall the Life I Lived Among You".

DAVID KANTOR is a long-time student of The URANTIA Book and has been producing multi-media programs on topics from the book for over ten years. David comes from a background of management of a computer company, and he is currently the head of the multi-media division of The Family of God Foundation in Clayton, California.

May 9 & 10

"RELATIONSHIPS: A PSYCHO-SOCIAL PERSPECTIVE" by Buck & Arlene Weimer.

An in-depth study of personality development, male-female differences, and learning self-forgetfulness will be presented by Arlene. Buck will share the sociological view of relationships, with a special emphasis on group dynamics and social roles.

BUCK & ARLENE WEIMER, after much world traveling, were introduced to The URANTIA Book in Florida 12 years ago. They were very involved with study groups and the Society in Los Angeles before moving to Pueblo, CO in 1975, and were among the founding members of RMUSD. Arlene has a Ph.D. in psychology, is a consultant, and has a private clinical practice. Buck has a B.A. in sociology and is presently an alcoholic counselor. They are the parents of three young boys, and are editing a book on marriage and family for Julia Fenderson of FUSLA.

May 23 & 24

"THE UFO PHENOMENON: A MAJOR CHALLENGE TO THE CONVENTIONAL WORLD PARADIGM. A PRELUDE TO CULTURE CONTACT?" by Richard Sigismund.

The UFO phenomenon is seen as an imminent interface between our Earth society and a larger, surrounding, Reality. This seminar will include an historical update on the UFO phenomenon as well as a current "Analysis of the Situation" presented from the perspective of a social scientist and philosopher.

RICHARD SIGISMUND is recognized as one of the country's leading researchers of the UFO phenomenon. A social scientist with a wide background in psychology, sociology, cultural anthropology and intellectual history, Mr. Sigismund has lectured widely on the UFO subject, has worked with the national television media as consultant to documentaries and has appeared on a number of radio and television programs.

June 13 & 14

"RELIGION AND THE COMPELLING NEEDS OF MANKIND AT THE END OF THE 20th CENTURY" by Gary Dangerfield.

What are the five most compelling needs of mankind as we approach the end of the 20th century? Could the truth about Jesus Christ really meet those needs? Are you sure that you are promoting the IDEALS rather than the IDEAS of Jesus? Are you trying to minister out of an empty heart? How could eternity's viewpoint put it all in perspective? These and other questions will be addressed.

GARY DANGERFIELD has a broad background of experience, having served as a Baptist pastor for 10 years, as Executive Director for Youth for Christ for Southwest Minnesota for 4 years, and as Dean of Students for Markoma Bible Academy for 2 years. Three years ago, after discovering The URANTIA Book, Gary chose to resign the pastorate of his conservative church and begin a new career in the insurance industry.
