Minutes of Meeting October 11, 1985

Present: John Hay (President), Joan Batson, Don Green, Jill Hull, Tom Pfeiffer, Errol Strider, Lou Meyer (Secretary).
Guests: Stan Hartman, Steve Rohrbach, Don Guimond.

The first point of discussion was on the question of who is the Chairperson of the Chair Committee. It was agreed that John Hay would fill this position.

Don Guimond presented a proposal from the Jesusonian Foundation concerning the editing and distribution of the video tapes of the seminars held at the School. The proposal is enclosed with these minutes. The proposal in general was favored by all, but no decisions were made. Further consideration was called for.

A committee reported that a winter intensive program would not be planned for this year.

Discussion on the purpose and goals of the Boulder School was resumed. Errol had asked the students to write down their views on this subject. He read these statements to the members. It was observed that the dominant note expressed by the students was the desire for personal spiritual growth and for greater dedication to service.

Joan expressed the need of effective teachers and leaders for spreading the fifth epochal revelation. To this end, she thought that the school should provide creative methods of learning, such as practice teaching in class and exploring methods of spiritual growth.

Don Green suggested more student participation in teaching opportunities such as ministry on C.U. campus.

John reviewed for the group the statement of the School's purpose as presented in the School Bulletin.

Errol offered a list of questions for course study for the School. These questions are attached to these minutes and the members are requested to study them and be prepared to discuss them at the next trustee meeting.

In the discussion about the preparation of next year's School Bulletin, Joan suggested that a workshop be held for those presenters scheduled to lead the classes. All favored this suggestion. Jill and Errol volunteered to participate in such a workshop.

Jill suggested that the trustees bring their specific ideas on the School's program in written form to the next meeting, in order that our discussions be less general and scattered. This suggestion was approved.

The meeting was adjourned after agreement to hold the next meeting at 3:30 P.M. on Friday, November 1, at the home of Tom Pfeiffer.
