

Let it be stated here that the purpose and intent of this proposal is to attempt to develop existing areas within the Boulder School that the Jesusonian Foundation can take a participatory role. This is being done in order to foster better cooperation between the Boulder School and Jesusonian Foundation.

Let it also be stated that the long range objectives of this program is to establish a video department that will entail an Executive Producer, Producer, Director, Technical Editor, Two Camera Operators, a Sound Person and a Lighting Person.

#### **REQUESTED USE OF DONATION FROM JESUSONIAN FOUNDATION**

1. That Don Guimond be designated Executive Producer for editing work done with said donation.
2. That Executive Producer will designate which tapes are to edited.
3. That Executive Producer will establish theme and information to be put on edited tapes from existing tapes.
4. The Executive Producer will appoint who will be the Producer for this project.
5. That an individual will be brought in from the University of Colorado Video Department to show Steve Rohrbach, Paul Harden and Kip Heinold all of the uses and functions of the video equipment presently at the Boulder School.
6. That no more than \$15.00 be used for the purchase of raw video tape, \$22.50 to be used by the school for maintenance and repair on the equipment, the balance to be applied to the cost of bringing in an expert in video equipment usage and editing and the remaining balance be used to pay the instructor/editor at a rate of \$7.50/hour. Due to Steve Rohrbach existing experience with the equipment, he will be the instructor/editor once the expert has explained the equipment.
7. That the Jesusonian Foundation have access to this particular edited tape for distribution and copying. The Boulder School will receive a copy for their loaning library.
8. Jesusonian Foundation will attempt to promote and sell the tape on a cost of goods only basis, and at the same time inform people of the tapes availability through the Boulder School loaning library.
9. Also that access be available to the Jesusonian Foundation for the production of video tapes that glean the best of several seminars on special subjects (i.e. Family, Outreach, etc.) and have access to the video equipment at the Boulder School for the production of new video tapes other than seminars, such as testimonials, special subject discussions (Bible, etc.) or study group tapes of classes at the school.

Addendum to Jesusonian Proposal for Video Department

6. That of the \$300.00 Donation no more than \$15.00 be used for the purchase of raw video tape, \$22.50 to used initially for equipment maintenance and repair (with a reevaluation of this amount in the near future to determine whether this amount is adequate based on the amount of time the equipment is utilized for this project), an amount of no more than \$100.00 be utilized for bring in someone fom the University of Colorado Video Department, and the balance to be used in the process of editing/instructing at a rate of \$7.50/hour for paying Steve Rorhbach to function in this role.
8. Jesusonian Foundation will attempt to promote this tape and at the same time inform people of the Boulder Schools loaning library.
- 8a. For tapes created through editing of Seminar tapes they will be sold only with the approval of both the presenter and Urantia Foundation. If approval from the Urantia Foundation is not possible some other method of distribution will be worked and will not implemented without the approval of the Board of Trustees for the Boulder School.
