DAILY FORMAT

Every day of school each student will be required to come in with 2 questions from the paper assigned for that day. These questions are to be in a multiple choice form of four choices, with three wrong choices formulated as well as the right one. Each student should have an additional question on hand in case one of their questions has already been used by another student. Before class each day, students will give their questions and answers to Carl Pickering in the front office.

Classes will begin each day at 1:30 P. M. with 10 minutes of prayer and worship. Then the instructor for that day will present a 5-15 minute talk pertaining to the paper for that day. The remainder of the first hour will be given to open discussion of the paper for the day. Then, at 2:30 each day, will be the first 15 minute break. At 2:45, the second hour of classes will begin; this hour will be devoted to going over the questions and answers given by each student. At the beginning of the second hour, the questions handed in, and having been typed up by Carl, will be given out to the students for a short 15 minute quiz. After the quiz is over, the instructor for the week will go over the questions and answers with the students for the remainder of the hour. At this time each student will have the opportunity to grade his or her own paper, and ask any questions they may have. At 3:45, the second 15 minute break begins.

On Monday and Tuesday the final hour of class will be devoted to the topic discussion of that week. Each week a student other than the normal instructor for that week will choose a topic from which they will lead the class in open discussion and readings from various parts of The URANTIA Book. The last hour on Thursday afternoon will be open for the class instructor to present a synopsis and review of that week's work. Each day classes will end at 4:55, with the last 5 minutes given to silent prayer and meditation.
