BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Minutes of Meeting January 9, 1986

Present: John Hay (President), Joan Batson, Jill Hull,
Tom Pfeiffer, Lou Meyer (Secretary).
Guests: Stan Hartman, Steve Rohrbach.

John reported on his conversation with Asana Duex concerning the possibility of his coming to Boulder as a facilitator for a meeting of the Trustees, as discussed in a previous meeting. It was agreed between them that the School Board would not really need an outside facilitator at this time and so, Asana will not be coming.

The trustees unanimously agreed to have Errol introduce a class in "living the religion of Jesus". This will be held for one hour a week - during one of the hours presently scheduled. Errol has been asked to prepare for the Board a detailed and written outline of what he proposes to teach.

Steve and Lou were asked to prepare a mock-up of the 1986-1987 School Bulletin to present to the Board at the next meeting. A course by Don Guimond on the Bible is to be included in next year's program.

Steve announced that the Christmas Party netted a profit of \$276.50. This amount has been credited to the School as a donation.

We discussed the question of whether the School should renew an advertisement placed last year in the National Resource publication. It was agreed to discontinue it.

One of the seminar speakers scheduled for this winter quarter cancelled out. It was discussed whether a fourth speaker should be scheduled for the spring quarter. The decision was made to have only the two seminars this quarter and keep the number at three for the next quarter.

Regarding the question of whether the School needs to move to a different location, John reported that his lawyer thinks nothing needs to be done about it for the present. The city has not presented an updated statement of requirements as it had indicated it would.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 5, 4 P.M. at the School.
