John gave a report on the possibility of relocating the School. While the St. Gertrude's Academy is not totally out of the question, a more acceptable financial arrangement would have to be offered before further consideration could be given to that property.

The Unity Church building on Spruce Street is for sale. Space there is adequate, but parking facilities are poor and the price asked seems too steep.

Meanwhile, we should be able to remain at our present location at least until the end of the present school year. Steps are being taken to see if we can meet the City's conditions laid down for our remaining here.

Graduation was discussed for the School's four graduates of this year: Joan Batson, Michael Benda, Paul Harden, and Carol Hay. It was agreed that the ceremony will be held on Thursday, June 19, at 7 P.M. at the School. A potluck will follow in the backyard. Tom offered to coordinate this.

The next question on the agenda was the matter of possibly hiring Jeff Wattles as full-time teacher/director for the School. Copies of a letter from Jeff, outlining some of his ideas, were given to all the members. After a lengthy discussion it was agreed that before a decision would be made, Jeff should be invited to speak to the Board in person. John said he would try to have Jeff come next week and a Board meeting would be set up after hearing from Jeff.

Brian Stafford also prepared a further statement about his ideas for the position of a full-time School facilitator. In particular he outlined a plan of study of the Jesus Papers for the coming scholastic year. Copies of this were given to all the members and there will be a discussion of his proposals at the next meeting.
