Dave will explore the teachings of The URANTIA Book in relationship to the living of everyday life and the contribution each individual can make to the eventual transformation of our planet. The major theme for both evenings will be the need to shift individual consciousness from ego-centered to God-centered concepts, to facilitate the experience of God in every aspect of life experience.

Dave, the President of URANTIA Brotherhood, has been a reader of The URANTIA Book since 1970. A resident of Darien, Connecticut, married for 20 years, with two sons in college, he is chairman of the Darien Youth Commission and coaches the Darien High School hockey team. Dave is self-employed as a real estate developer. He is deeply committed to both the inner and outer consequences of the teachings of The URANTIA Book and devotes much of his time, energy, and resources to this work, participating in local study group and society activities as well as central organization functions.

"TEACHING AND LEARNING METHODOLOGIES" and "RELEASING THE SPIRITUAL ARTIST WITHIN" by Patrick Yesh

People have different intellectual abilities and problem-solving skills; Patrick will indicate how to identify different learning styles. In the first seminar we will discover how to adjust the teaching style to the learning style. Art attempts to portray our vision of Paradise perfection as reflected in time and space. Our most creative act, according to Patrick, is developing a superb self-concept both in children and in ourselves. This workshop uses some art therapy techniques to explore the creative potential of the superconscious. We will pursue painting and drawing as methods of spiritual communication.

Patrick has been a teacher for nearly a decade on an Indian reserve in Canada. He has taught art and language in Federal and Provincial school systems. During the past half year, he has been pursuing a career as an artist—painting, studying, and giving workshops.
