NULLIFICATION AGREEMENT

In re an agreement between:

THE BOULDER SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS OF THE URANTIA BOOK

and

THE JESUSONIAN FOUNDATION

On October 11, 1985, Donald Guimond, speaking in behalf of the Jesusonian Foundation, presented a proposal to the Board of Trustees of the Boulder School for Students of The URANTIA Book.

This proposal concerned a request by the Jesusonian Foundation to participate in the work of the School's video department.

The proposal was basically an agreement by the Jesusonian Foundation to donate funds toward the School's video program, and, on the part of the School, to grant certain rights to said Foundation to edit and distribute School-produced tapes - contingent upon approval of the Urantia Foundation - and to generally have access to the School's video equipment and production facilities.

WHEREAS, this agreement between the Boulder School and the Jesusonian Foundation was approved by the School Trustees on November 22, 1985; and

WHEREAS, no editing or reproducing of tapes have been made during the fifteen months following this agreement; and

WHEREAS, it has become obvious to both parties that this arrangement is no longer of significant value; and

WHEREAS, both parties favor nullifying the agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, it is agreed by both parties as follows:

- I. The Boulder School will return to the Jesusonian Foundation the three hundred dollars donation that was made.
- II. The Jesusonian Foundation relinquishes now and for the future all rights to edit, reproduce, or distribute any video tape or any other production by the Boulder School.
- III. The Jesusonian Foundation surrenders all access to the School's video equipment without prior express permission from the School.
