## SEMINAR/WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT

### ***LOVING YOUR ENEMY***

This seminar/workshop will focus on practical ways to reach the understanding you need to really love your enemies - not only outer enemies, but inner enemies as well (with the goal being to do away with the enemy experience altogether, non-violently).

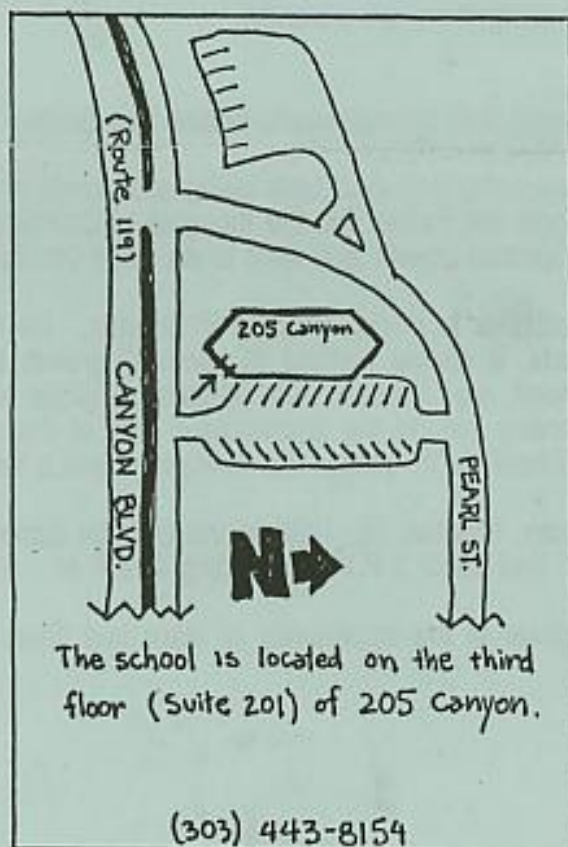
