Thank you for what proved for me to be a wonderful conference.

After I told you that I was letting go of the emotional burdens that I have carried since my years in Boulder, I was able to recognize some chronic problems of my own which contributed to difficulties then. Specifically, I want to confess my own intellectual elitism, moralism, and intolerance which made for a climate of rigidity and tension rather than the progressive atmosphere - "stimulated by difficulties" - that was called for.

Thank you for the opportunity to study and teach during those years. A lot of healing took place at the conference. I trust the eventual harvest of our efforts will justify the ^{young} faith and sweat your faith in and sacrifice for us.
