Dear Steve:

At the Executive Committee meeting on April 22, 1995, I got the impression, incorrectly I hope, that the Fellowship intends for the Index currently being prepared by the Boulder School to be the Fellowship's exclusive property. Such exclusive control by the Fellowship was not agreed to by the School.

As explicitly stated at the March 11 General Council meeting, works produced by the Boulder School are available to the Fellowship and others without copyright restrictions and without a grant of exclusive right-to-use being granted to FEF or anyone else. While we have been and remain willing to work with FEF on timing of availability of certain features to other parties, it is not now, nor has it ever been, contemplated that FEF would have exclusive use of any materials produced by the Boulder School.

If FEF has the heretofore unstated intention to exert some form of control over the Index being prepared by the School, this letter will serve to notify FEF that BS will not grant such exclusive rights to our work. If the FEF views its recent payments to BS as anything other than unrestricted assistance to the BS for the completion of work for the benefit of all readers, BS will return payments made to it by FEF and will seek support for its work elsewhere.

I hope that FEF would not intend to so freely accept the results of the work made possible by the unrestricted donations of others and then expect to retain exclusive control over whatever might be produced during the period that it makes contributions to the effort.
