"SPRING REGIONAL CONFERENCE"

The Spring Eastern Regional Conference was held at "Elbanobscot" an environmentally protected camp and school ground in Sudbury, Mass. From the windows of the main meeting hall was a wildlife vista that looked over the school grounds and water lowland.

The Paxton (Mass.) group made all the arrangements for shelter and meals while the Clinton (Conn.) group volunteered to provide the presentations.

Nick Scalzo spoke first presenting a very well thought out explanation of "Trinities, Triunities and Triodities". In his talk he used visual aids to depict the inter-relations of the Seven Absolutes and their various combinations. (con't.)

The second presentation "Cosmography" was the joint effort of Don Kaiser, the moderator, Marguerite Savoy, Beach Barrett, and Carl Marsden. Marguerite presented colored drawings of all the capital spheres from Jerusem to Uversa. Beach explained two large black lit paintings, one showing a top view of the Central Universe and the other a cross section or side view of the Central Universe portraying the organization of pervaded and unpervaded space. After lunch, Carl gave a very thorough talk on the Seven Superuniverses. Using wooden models he explained the spatial layout of the Grand Universe and described the many subdivisions of Superuniverse administration.

For reversion a band called "Band X" led by Craig Peyton, with Alan GRZYB, Victor Preston, Joey Bellomo, played a series of songs dedicated love and other feelings inspired by the URANTIA Book.

The final talk on marriage and family life was presented by Dick Johnson, DeDe Scalzo and Elaine Yatroussis. Mr. Johnson spoke on the institution of family life in the 20th century as related to the URANTIA Book. Mrs. Scalzo presented a talk on the evolution of family life and Mrs. Yatroussis based her presentation on the paper "Life on a Neighboring Planet" and the possible impact of some of their practices if adopted on our planet.

PLANTING A SEED

Offering the Book to a Friend...

In our eagerness to share the URANTIA Book, we might do well to conjecture about our expectations. After all, this is a life changing book; most people should want to know what it has to say! Its answers to the most profound and baffling questions should attract large readership; its application to everyday life should charm a wide assortment of people!

Really?

Pause to consider those who won't read the URANTIA Book:

 a) a considerable percent of the population for reasons of intellectual limitation, and real or supposed inability to read more than very simple sentences;

b) a portion of the population have, or will tell you they have, little or no interest in "anything religious" and have established a life style filled with activities and other dedications; (con't. on pg. 4.)

 c) a good number are happy with their religious framework, a comfortable church or other group affiliation, and/or devotion to some sacred writings as truth;

d) countless people won't read it because

they never come across it!

Here we are, trying to reduce the size of these groups, especially the last one. And most of us have at one time or another wanted to shout about it from the housetops, write about it under banner headlines, buy radio or TV time. And then came recognition that this isn't the way.

So what remains? To be sure that every person we know or meet is aware that such a book exists. THAT'S ALL, at least at first. With trials and disappointments, many dedicated Urantians have cultivated a technique of graciousness, a skill at offering the book with empathy for the recipient. One touches tender nerves when asking, even by inference, "What is your relationship with God?"

Among us we can let our enthusiasm spill out; our assurance is attractive to another who is equally sure. But it may be a threat or an affront to someone who is a stranger to the

URANTIA teachings.

"I've been reading a beautiful and unusual book." "This book is different from any other I know." "A friend gave me this book and I am enjoying it." "There are some surprising statements in here about astronomy (or government or marriage)." Then stand back and wait. When questions come, use the book for the answers, (even about the authorship!). Restrain opinion, offer few interpretations, beware of even a hint of coercion.

Take each chance to help friends to "come across it", with willingness to go slowly, and modest expectations about results. And say, in whatever way is yours, "I love you anyway, even if you don't read my book."

Because this is what reading it tells us.
