The retreat fee is \$290 and includes lodging, meals (vegetarian available), and airport shuttle. A deposit of \$100 per person is required. **Prompt registration is advised due to limited capacity.** All registration must be completed by mail. Cancellations will be accepted in writing prior to April 15, 1999. Balance of fee is due by May 1, 1999. Check in begins at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, May 28; check out is by 2:00 p.m. on Memorial Day, Monday, May 31.
